

# Use potentials of youths: Biswas

President Abdur Rahman Biswas Sunday stressed the need for utilisation of the potentials of the youth force to bring about a solution to the manifold problems of the country, reports BSS.

He said favourable conditions should be made to organise the youth to absorb them massively into the development activities.

President Biswas was exchanging views with a 12-member delegation of the Jubo Kalyan Sangha of Muktagacha under Mymensingh district in Dhaka when they called on him at Bangabhaban. Golam Hossain, president of the sangha led the delegation. The President said the in-

tegrity and sincerity of the youths were the main pre-requisite for changing the country's socio-economic condition. He also laid stress on turning the youths into resource persons to achieve the country's prosperity.

Referring to the education, the President said education inspires people in building the society and called for spreading the light of education among the masses to broaden their outlook.

President Biswas also underscored the need for building rural infrastructures including communications and setting up of more educational institutions for the interest of the uninterrupted progress and prosperity.

He also urged the socio-political workers and youths to put in their best efforts to achieve speedy development of their respective areas.

The president also assured the delegation members that he would look into their problems including supply of natural gas and setting up of a BSCIC estate in Muktagacha.

# Plan to set up 12 mass literacy centres in each thana

A comprehensive project for launching mosque based mass literacy programme throughout the country will be undertaken soon, reports BSS.

This was disclosed at a meeting in the Ministry of Religious Affairs with State Minister for Religious Affairs Prof. MA Mannan in the chair in Dhaka yesterday.

Among others, present in the meeting were Secretary of the Ministry of Religious Affairs Abdul Awal, Director General of Islamic Foundation Al-haj Mansurul Haq Khan and concerned officials of the Ministry of Religious Affairs and Islamic Foundation.

It was decided in the meeting that the project would be run under direct supervision of

Islamic Foundation Bangladesh and a separate cell had already been opened for advancing the programme for implementation.

Decision has been taken to open 12 mass literacy centres in each thana with three follow-up library. The imams of the mosques would be given preference as teachers.

The project would be started to give education to children of three age groups: 4-5 years, 6-10 years and 11-14 years.

All measures would also be taken to check the drop-out of children.

The State Minister urged all to work with sincerity to make the programme a complete success.
