Operation August '92

150 arms recovered, 1383 held in Chittagong

CHITTAGONG, Aug 18: Chittagong district police rounded up 1383 miscreants and recovered 150 fire arms from August 1 to 15 under their operation August '92 drive, a police press release said in Dhaka Tuesday, reports BSS.

Absconders, illegal toll collectors, terrorists and maastans were among the miscreants.

One SMG, eight foreign rifles, 18 guns, four revolvers, 21 light guns, 98 pipe guns were, among the fire arms, recovered from different areas of the district. Police also recovered 1193 rounds of ammunition, three wireless sets, four grenades, two cocktails, two boyenets during the drive.

Police also recovered contraband cigarettes and wine worth over Tk 3 lakh during the drive.

Farabi's works can inspire young generation

The works of Khan Mohammad Farabi, who died in 1974 at the age of 22 years, can inspire the young generation who are now living in an age of terrorism and violence with his poems, essay and stories.

Speakers at the publication ceremony of Khan Mohammad Farabi's collected works held at the National Museum Tuesday paid rich tributes to memory of the late literatureur and recalled his contributions in the field of literature. Farabi achieved the qualities of a classic writer at a very young age, they observed.

The book was published by the Bangla Academy while Sahitya Academy, Brahmanbaria organised the function. The function presided over by Director General of Bangla Academy was attended among others by Professor Anisuzzaman as the chief guest, Principal Mohammad Noman, Prof Abdullah Abu Syeed, Shamsuzzaman Khan, Khan Sarwar Murshed, Shantanu Kaisar, Selina Hossain and others.

Many of his writings were inspired by Marxism and Leninism, the speakers observed. Some of his books were on surrealism, deep philosophical quest and some were witty and humorous.

They also said, Farabi was respected by the elders for his knowledge and creativity.

Country-wide sweetmeat shop strike today

The owners of sweetmeat shops of the country will observe a strike today (Wednesday) in protest against sealing of 15 shops in the city by the National Board of Revenue (NBR) for non-payment of VAT.

Demanding immediate reopening of the shops, the Dhaka Mohanagari Mistaanna Baboshayee Kallyan Samity (DMMDKS) has also been observing a three day strike programme in the city from Tuesday.

In a press conference held Tuesday at National Press Club, leaders of DMMDKS and Bangladesh Mistaanna Bya-boshayee condemned the action and termed it 'undemocratic'.

The press conference was attended among others by Samity President Alhaj Mohammad Harun Ur Rashid, Biswanath Ghosh, Alhaj Mohammad Ali, Alhaj A Momen, Maidul Alam Titu and others.
