**Jamaat protests DU teachers' demand**

Jamaat-e-Islami yesterday protested a joint statement issued recently by 102 teachers of Dhaka University demanding ban on Jamaat-e-Islami.

The City Ameer of Jamaat ATM Azharul Islam and Secretary General Jastumuddin Sarkar in their protest statement said that they didn't expect such demand from the teachers of DU, known as the Oxford of the East.

The Jamaat leaders termed the teacher's demand undemocratic and dirty, and demanded withdrawal of their demands.

**Attempt on Menon's life designed to create anarchy, chaos: Huda**

Information Minister Nazmul Huda yesterday said the attempt on the life of Workers Party General Secretary Rashed Khan Menon, MP, was made with an ulterior political design to create anarchy and chaos in the country, reports BSS.

He strongly condemned the politics of a well-planned killing by the forces discarded by the people and said that those self-seeking politicians should be unmasked before the nation.

The Information Minister was addressing the publication

ceremony of Shawkat Chowdhury's first Bengali novel 'Khab' (dream) as the special guest, at Jatiya Press Club auditorium.

Eminent journalist Glas Kamal Chowdhury also addressed the ceremony as the special guest while poet Al-Mujahidi of the Daily Ittefaq and the senior Vice-President of Al-Baraka Bank Nasir Uddin Ahmad discussed the novel.

The Information Minister said the forces isolated from the people engineered attempt on the life of Menon for getting a body, spread false rumours and resorted to violent activities like damaging vehicles to vitiate the proper political and democratic atmosphere of the country to fish in the troubled waters.

He said those who spread false rumours had a link with the attempt on the life of Menon.

Huda said radio and television had broadcast bulletin on the development of Menon's condition to scotch the rumour spread by the evil forces.

'At this, the agitation created by the evil forces calmed down and the motive of the conspirators was foiled' he said.

Barrister Huda said certain quarters were now out to create division and unrest in the national life by giving wrong interpretation about the 'Bangladeshi' nationalism.

'Bangladeshi nationalism is the combination of all languages, religions, traditions and cultures prevailing in this particular sovereign land,' he said.

The minister said that there was no scope for identifying Bangladeshi nationalism on the basis of only a language although the Bengali speaking people were identified as Bangalee nation in that way. He said there are other sects belonging to separate languages and religions in the country apart from the Bangalees.

The Information Minister said there was no scope for creating any controversy about Bangladeshi nationalism, 'the controversy arises at a time when efforts are made to establish a link between the Bangali nationhood of this land and that of outside the country and also to identify this nation of 2,500 years old tradition through a so-called father of the 20th century,' he said.

**UNFPA praises success of FP programmes in Bangladesh**

Dr Nafis Sadik, Executive Director of UNFPA, has praised the Matlab experience of Family Planning (FP) programmes in Bangladesh according to a report from Bali (Indonesia).

Talking to BSS, she said the Matlab experience could be replicated elsewhere in the world. She was of the view that all developing countries should reassess their national problems and allocate increased funds out of their own resources for Family Planning programmes. The donor countries would like to see that the developing countries themselves take initiatives in solving the population problem, she added.

Praising the overall success of FP programmes in Bangladesh, the UNFPA Executive Director said she had proposed to Bangladesh government to consider inclusion of the Family Planning issue in the forthcoming SAARC summit, scheduled to be held in Dhaka in December. She said she would visit Dhaka before the summit in this connection.

**11 tribals rewarded for killing leader of Shantibahini toll collectors**

RANGAMATI, Aug 21: Eleven tribals here have been rewarded for killing a leader of armed toll collectors of outlawed Shantibahini and recovering arms and ammunition of his group, reports UNB.

They laid an ambush in the dense forest of Farua in Bilachari thana on August 17 and gunned down Pran Kirton Chakma, a ferocious leader of toll extortionists of the tribal insurgents, official sources said.

Three associates of Kirton jumped into the Raingkhong river after being beaten up by the 11 local tribals who grouped to resist the toll collectors of tribal insurgents.

The terrorists left behind one SBBJ gun, two country made guns, one cartridge, four torches, five booklets on Jhoomland, Bangladeshi Taka

140 and Indian Rupees, 1,020. All the recovered items were handed over to the security forces in Farua camp.

Local people alleged that Kirton Chakma and his associates used to extort tolls from the poor tribals who earn their livelihood by cutting bamboo from the dense forest of the district.

Kirton was wanted in connection with a number of criminal cases, including abduction, torture on innocent people and toll collection, since 1986.

The 11 tribals were rewarded in cash and kind for their courageous acts in resisting the armed toll collectors of the outlaws. The awards were distributed among them by the Commander of Kaptai Army Region on Tuesday.

**Youths urged to resist terrorism**

Dhaka City Corporation Mayor Mirza Abbas yesterday called upon the youth to resist terrorism, conspiracy and anarchy for consolidating democracy in the country, reports BSS.

Addressing a conference of the youth at the intersection of Goran, the Mayor said certain known circles were indulging in spreading terrorism everywhere in a pre-planned way to cover their isolation from the masses. Accusing these circles of amassing fabulous wealth through looting and plundering national wealth in past, he said they were now patronising the anarchists in accordance with a blue print to jeopardize the country's independence.

He appealed to all sections of people to beware of the conspirators and so-called people's sympathisers.
