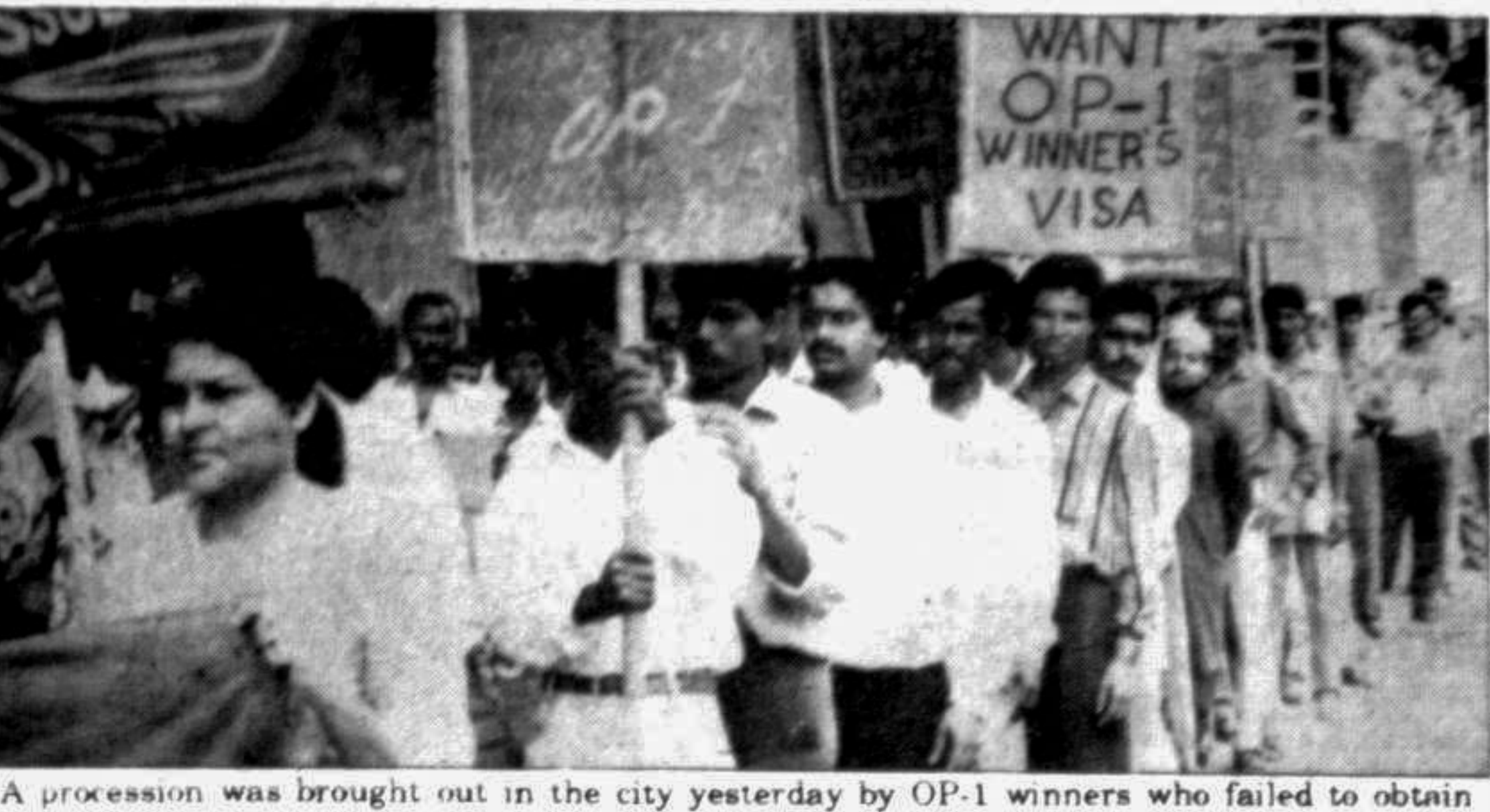
Dhaka not included in US visa lottery

 The United States has announced another "Visa lottery" programme for the year '92, '93 and '94 but Bangladesh is not included in the immigration programme, according to the OP-1 US Immigration Lottery Winners Association in Dhaka Monday.
 A report published in the daily Yomiuri newspaper in Japan on July 25, said The State Department of the United States will accept applications between July 29 and August 28 for registration in a visa lottery programme that will provide 40,000 immigrant visas to natives of 36 countries and areas during US fiscal 1993.
 The report also said that the AA-1 immigrant visa programme gives 40,000 immigrant visas to natives of the specified countries and areas, including Japan, in each of the US fiscal years '92, '93 and '94 under a section of the US Immigration Act of '90.
 The report, however, did not mention anything about Bangladesh and the US embassy officials in Dhaka were not available for comment.
 The Yomiuri said that applications for registration will be selected strictly at random from those received during the stipulated time.
 Since there is no application form, those who wish to apply were requested to type or clearly print in the Roman alphabet, the name, date of birth, place of birth and other particulars.
 The report gave a post box number of Dulles, Virginia, USA to which the applications were to be mailed from anywhere in the world within the stipulated date.
 Meanwhile, the OP-1 US Immigration lottery winners, who were not issued visas from Bangladesh, appealed to the US authorities to include them in the AA-1 programme, but no response yet, the association source said.

Closer cooperation among SAARC countries stressed

A national seminar here on the concluding day yesterday underscored the need for closer regional cooperation, observing that it was the most vital catalyst for confidence building among the seven members of the South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation (SAARC), reports BSS.
 The two-day seminar, organised jointly by the Bangladesh Institute of International and Strategic Studies (BIISS) and the Department of International Relations, Dhaka University, further stated that the continuous dialogue between various Non-Governmental Organisations to promote greater understanding within South Asia was an inevitable necessity.
 The participants discussed at length and depth the issues related to strengthening regional cooperation in the South Asia. It also viewed that the recent far-reaching changes in the international political, economic and strategic order have significantly added to the imperatives for strengthening regional cooperation.
 According to the draft summary of the proceeding, the participants took unanimous position that in order to be effective, the SAARC must immediately include the core economic areas into its agenda of cooperation.
 Welcoming the progress and basic preparatory works already done in this regard they urged all concerned to concentrate toward promoting intra-regional trade and to implement the agreement on preferential trade agreement.
 The concept of 'dal-bhat' as a catalyst to food security in the region was also elaborately discussed.
