US counsellor says Freedom of press basic human right

Asserting that freedom of expression and of the press are basic human rights, the United States has called on the UN Subcommission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities to cease all further work on 'admissible' restrictions on press freedom, a press release of USIS says.

In a statement to the sub-commission in Geneva August 25, John Crook, legal affairs counsellor at the US Mission to the United Nations in Geneva, said 'freedom of expression and the press are fundamental for the creation and functioning of a healthy society.'

Crook recalled in his statement to the 26-member body of independent human rights experts that Article 19 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights provides 'unalqualified' guarantees for freedom of speech and the press.

Crook was referring to certain provisions of the international covenant on Civil and Political Rights, which entered into force in 1976, and to a just-completed subcommission study on the right to freedom of opinion and expression.

Crook noted that the study is based on the premise that controls on expression and the press are sometimes justified and advances 'an intellectual framework for determining the extent of allowable controls.'
