The Five-Party alliance yesterday called on the government to arrest the killer group immediately unweaving the mystery surrounding the assassination bid on Rashed Khan Menon and also take steps against terrorists within the BNP, reports UNB.

The alliance also urged the democratic forces to unitedly build resistance against the terrorist-killer groups.

The call came from a meeting of the alliance held today (Monday) with Nirmal Sen in the chair.
