

Speakers at a seminar on Newspapers, Journalists and Readers: "Expectation and Achtevement" held at Savar yesterday stressed the need for maintaining objectivity in journalism for establishing a welfare-oriented society, reports UNB.

They also called upon all, including political parties and influential quarters, to cooperate with the journalists in discharging their responsibilities independently.

The seminar was organised by Jahangirnagar University Journalists Association on the occasion of its 19th founding anniversary at the social science gallery of the university. Addressing the seminar.

journalist Shafiq Rehman said ours is a country of 12 crore people but the number of real newspaper readers is not even one per cent. This is not a good sign for the newspaper industry", he said. "Journalists also face a


