Need for objective journalism stressed

Speakers at a seminar on Newspapers, Journalists and Readers, "Expectation and Achievement" held at Savar yesterday stressed the need for maintaining objectivity in journalism for establishing a welfare-oriented society, reports UNB.

They also called upon all, including political parties and influential quarters, to cooperate with the journalists in discharging their responsibilities independently.

The seminar was organised by Jahangirnagar University Journalists Association on the occasion of its 19th founding anniversary at the social science gallery of the university.

Addressing the seminar, journalist Shafiq Rehman said ours is a country of 12 crore people but the number of real newspaper readers is not even one per cent. This is not a good sign for the newspaper industry, he said.

Journalists also face a number of problems in performing their duties like pressure from the newspaper owners, hawkers as well as the readers' Rehman said.

He urged the government and other influential groups to stop repression on the journalists and let the journalist community to work freely.

Speaking on the role of readers, he pointed out that no reader protested the termination of Shahriar Kabir.

Abed Khan of the Daily Ittefaq said the country has a total of 41 dailies and 434 weeklies but a few of them reflect hopes and aspiration of the people.

He said after the independence in 1971 Awami League

and JSD have used the newspapers to reflect their political philosophy and during the last autocratic regime the newspaper industry was as a device to make black money white.

Khan said journalists and never reach the expectation of the people unless pressure of the owners is withdrawn. "We cannot write what we believe even when there is press freedom in the country," he said.

In this context, he mentioned that the radio stations of Chittagong, Sylhet and Rajshahi are compelled by the Jamaatis to broadcast their political views.

Akbar Hossain MP, told the seminar that if welfare of the people is the main goal of journalists they can do that within all limitations. He advised the journalists to base their reports on facts to meet the expectation of the people.

Santosh Gupta of the Daily Sangbad laid special emphasis on maintaining neutrality by the journalists. "A good reporter should never be attached to a political party," he said.

He remarked that the growth of healthy journalism cannot be expected without ensuring healthy politics.

Referring to the unabated terrorism in the country, he said journalists can play a vital role in curbing terrorism.

He said newspapers are considered as unadorned opposition party and their criticism of the government is "constructive criticism."

The seminar was presided over by President of Jahangirnagar University Journalists Association Jufiqar Ahmed.
