Rly anti-smuggling drive soon

The railway authorities have decided to carry out antismuggling drive at some designated stations on Dhaka Chittagong route to stop movement of smuggled goods through railways, reports BSS.

Eight stations have been designated/identified to carry out the month-long drive in cooperation with BDR, police and railway employees. Railway sources said the decision to start the drive was taken at a joint meeting, held Tuesday at the railway rest house at Akhaura Station in view of recent increase of smuggling on the route. A magistrate of respective districts will lead the drive, the sources added.

The stations identified are Feni, Laksham, Comilla, Akhaura, Brahmanbaria, Bhairab bazar, Narsingdi and Kishore ganj. Besides trains on Dhaka Chfttagong routes, other trains arriving at the designated stations will also be thoroughly searched. The members of the raid will board the non-stop Mahanagar express trains and will disembark only at the destination.

The sources said smugglers were loading and unloading goods at different points either by forcing the driver to halt trains at gunpoint or making the signals ineffective. resulting in the stoppage of the trains. A number of railway employees were injured to obstruct smugglers in their nefarious acts, the sources
