'Nirmul body to continue movement'

Lt Col (ret'd) Kazi Nuruzzaman, chief coordinator of the Ghatak Dalai Nirmul Committee, at a rally Saturday called upon the political parties to reinforce the movement for implementation of the joint declaration of the three alliances.

ANUDIP collects 63 bags of blood

'Amra Nutun Diganter Pathik' (ANUDIP) a cultural organisation run by school and college-going student, on Friday collected 63 bags of blood in a voluntary blood collection campaign held at Salimullah Road, Mohammadpur in the city, report BSS.

During the day-long programme, the new-born organisation also held a reception for 45 students of the locality who obtained star marks in the 1992 SSC examinations. The successful students were also given certificates by the 'ANUDIP'.

The blood collected by the organisation was later handed over to the Bangladesh Red Crescent Blood Bank.

Abortion complications claim 8000 a year, study report says

About 8,000 induced abortions are being done in the country annually and at least 8,000 of them die following abortion related complications, according to a study conducted on the patients admitted to some selected medical facilities during 1989-90, reports BSS.

The sampled medical facilities included two medical college hospitals, two district hospitals and four upazila health complexes representing three major types of government hospital facilities and covering all four administrative divisions.

Non-therapeutic abortion is illegal in Bangladesh. But desperate women undergo induced abortion in the hands of unqualified persons, resulting in serious life threatening complications.

The report of the study conducted by Syed Feroza Begum, Halida Hanum Akhter, Haidary Kamal and Gulam Mostafa Kamal was presented at the 12th national conference of BIRPERHT, a reproductive health research institute, which began here Saturday.

Minister Chowdhury Kamal Ibne Yusuf inaugurated the conference at the NEC auditorium at Sher-e-Bangla Nagar.

The study conducted on 1300 patients showed that the mean period of gestation at admission was 13 weeks and 90 per cent of these cases had incomplete abortion and with bleeding.

About 60 per cent of these women with a mean age of about 27 years came from rural areas with lower educational level and poor economic background.

Over half of the abortions were induced by inserting herbs, plants and sticks, one third of the cases was induced by inserting stick through vagina, about a quarter by using injection, tablet, capsule and oral pill, 17.5 per cent by using indigenous drugs and the rest by menstrual regulation (MR) and others.

The single most important reason for deciding termination of pregnancy was that 62 per cent of the women did not want any more children. Among other reasons in 5.3 per cent cases husband did not want any more children, 6.1 per cent could not afford another child, 9.7 per cent considered it to be a problem, 9.3 per cent did not want due to studies, household work and outside work problem and 11.7 per cent due to health reasons or were unmarried, divorced, separated or widowed.

According to another study conducted by AKM Anwarul Azim and Sofia Nilufar on 3400 induced abortion patients admitted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital in three years, January 1989 to December 1991, about 13 per cent of them were septation abortions.

Septic abortion is the second most common cause of maternal death after eclampsia, the study report on 'maternal mortality from septic abortion,' presented at the conference said.

This study found that about 72 per cent of the abortions was induced by using the root of a tree while in 14 per cent cases it was induced by MR carried by unqualified persons and about 10 per cent had taken some abortifacient drugs given by unqualified persons.

Most of these patients had any knowledge of contraceptives or their uses and the available MR services, the report added.

Another paper on 'problems associated with supply of MR equipment and its impact on quality of MR services' presented by Haidary Kamal, Altaf Hossain and GM Kamal revealed that trained personnel could not provide MR services for want of necessary equipment and staff while those who were providing MR services had no institutional training.

In his inaugural speech, Health Minister Chowdhury Kamal Ibne Yusuf said the government was not getting feedback from the fields due to the lack of effective monitoring of family planning services.

Home Secretary Manzur-Ul Karim who was a former health secretary said due to lack of proper monitoring and supervision the field workers were not available in the respective areas and did not supply any information.
