## New tourist resort at Khepupara likely

The Government is plan-ning to develop a full-fledged tourist resort at Kuakata under Kehpupara thana of Patuakhali

Officials said the 18 kilometres long sea-beach will be developed into a modern tourist

Civil Aviation and Tourism Secretary Habibur Rahman, who visited Kuakata last week told UNB that the Government was planning to arrange a package tour for visitors to the spot by December this year.

The tourism policy, adopted last February, also envisaged development of Kuakata scabeach on a priority basis, he

The place will be developed in line with foreign resorts like those in Macao and Hongkong-providing facilities like golf course, casino and vatching.

Besides, an EPZ and a tourist seaport are being planned for the area, it was

The Government will provide infrastructure facilities ltke road communication and help develop publicity for promotion of the spot, Rahman

The Government is also lanning to seek advice from the UNDP for a Master Plan on the spot to make it a potential

A private sector firm, Labour Advisory Centre, has already submitted a proposal for development of the proposed resort at Kuakata.

Managing Director of the Centre Belayet Hossain told UNB that international hotel chain Holiday Inn has shown interest for setting up a threestar hotel in the area.

The sunrise and sunset views from Kuakata is as thrilling as similar scenic beauty that can be experienced at the resorts in Sri Lanka and Maldives. Kuakata can be ideally used for six months as a top-class resort from the month of September.

## Bangladesh to receive Tk 35 cr German aid for 2 projects

Bangladesh will receive 14.5 million Deutsche mark (about Taka 35 crore) as grants under two separate exchange of notes signed in Dhaka recently, reports BSS.

According to a PID source yesterday the grant amounts will be utilised for two projects- one for overhauling railway passenger coaches and the other for crop intensification project in Kurigram dis-

The ten million Deutsche mark (about Taka 24 crorc) grant is for general overhaul of 150 railway passenger coaches by June next year. Besides improving the availability of passenger coaches and training up of railway staff to ensure necessary overhaul of coaches at Sycdpur and Pahartali workshops, necessary inputs, equipment and vehicles will be procured for establishing a sustainable system of railway coach overhaul.

The coach project was agreed upon following inter-

governmental negotiation held here in 1990.

The second project amounting 4.5 million Deutsche mark (about Taka 11 crore) grant was given for implementation of the extended phase of the marginal and small crop intensification project in Kurigram district. The project was undertaken in collaboration with International Fund for Agriculture Development (IFAD) to attain sustainable improvement of living standards of small and marginal farmers through crop intensification.

Germany's contribution to the project included expert support, provision of necessary supply of material and equipment and training facilities. The eoach project was signed on September, while the crop was signed on August 25, the handout said.

Faizur Rahman, Joint Secretary of ERD and Dr Karl Heinz Scholtyssek signed the agreements on behalf of their respective governments.
