Sircar seeks agencies' support to gear up pry education

The Education Minister Barister Jamiruddin Sircar has been elected Vice-Chairman of the Commission on Educational Conference on Education being sponsored by UNESCO in Geneva, from September 14, according to a message received in Dhaka, reports BSS.

He presided over the first session of the Commission on September 14.

The Education Minister participated in the discussion on initiative of UNESCO and UNICEF to promote education for all in the developing countries as one of nine heads of delegations.

Sircar gave an out line of the compulsory primary education and mass education programmes of the present democratic government under leadership of Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia. He said, compulsory primary education and mass education programmes were introduced as priority programmes to eradicate illiteracy from Bangladesh by the year 2000 as per declaration of UNICEF.

He sought for increased support of UNESCO, UNICEF and other agencies for strengthening these programmes. The Director General of UNESCO assured increased cooperation for making these programmes a success.

Later, addressing the plenary session of the conference on September 15, Barister Sircar highlighted the policies and programmes of the government in the education sector.

He said universalisation of the primary education was the priority goal of education sector.

Illegal electronic goods seized from Foreign Post Office

A squad of Dhaka District Bureau of Anti-Corruption has seized a good number of illegal electronic goods worth about Taka 18 lakh from the Foreign Post Office in Dhaka, reports BSS.

The goods are 3,021 pieces of wrist watch of various brands including citizen quartz with golden colour and golden belts (ladies and gents) and Casio ladies and gents, one VCR, four pieces of VCP, 376 pieces of VCP head (spare parts), 84 pieces of jack of VCP and VCR, 184 pieces of cord and VCP's remote control.

These electronic goods, which were brought to the Foreign Post Office from the air sorting division, were found out from some parcels during their sorting, the handout said.

20-yr forestry master plan being formulated

Bangladesh is now formulating a 20-year forestry master plan (1993-2013) with a drastic change and massive investment to raise forest area to a minimum requirement of 25 per cent from the existing eight per cent for matching national demand and environmental conservation and to create employment opportunities.

Disclosing this Wednesday in an exclusive interview with BSS, Environment, Forest, Fisheries and Livestocks Minister Abdullah al-Noman said the forestry master plan to be finalised by December next would be able to create a social movement in the country in favour of forest development and environmental conservation leading the nation march forward on the path of development, progress and prosperity.

Tk 50 prize bonds draw results

Noman said the draft national forest policy had been prepared and the national conservation strategy was now at its final stage.

He said the democratically elected government of Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia was now implementing a Taka 157 crore Thana Nursery Programme ending June 1994 for the development of woodlot and agro-forestry in the country.

The government has already created a separate social forestry department for strengthening and expediting social afforestation programme and recovering the degraded forestry to turn the present efforts into a social movement with the participation of people, Noman added.

Spelling out the highlights of the draft forestry master plan, the Minister said the government was now chalking out a massive investment programme under the cover of the long-term forestry master plan to reduce the resource gap and expand the contribution of the

forest sector in the country by ensuring a productive and effective participation of the people and private initiatives.

Detailing the background of the master plan, the Minister said there was no long-term forestry plan in the country while a large scale destruction of resources and natural forest marked the most corrupt autocratic regime of Ershad.

The new master plan, he said, would incorporate comprehensive, sound and dynamic policies, new legislation to address the present forestry concerns, urgent restructuring of the forestry institutions, an effective and coordinated system of human resources development and strengthening the forestry research considering changed national, regional and global environmental situation.

He said the drastic change associated with high investment scenario of the master plan would yield the greatest sustained benefits in terms of environmental conservation, production and productivity cementing effective participation of the people.
