

'25 pc of ADP mobilised from domestic resources'

Planning Minister A M Zahiruddin Khan yesterday urged the government officials to devote themselves to hard and productive work for the welfare of the nation, reports BSS.

Speaking as the chief guest at a reception to newly recruited officers of the BCS (Economic) cadre at the NEC auditorium in the city, the minister said an opportunity had come to build the country with the installation of a popularly elected democratic and accountable government.

He said the government of Begum Khaleda Zia came to power through the first ever free and fair election after the independence of Bangladesh and added it would never compromise on the question of

accountability at all levels in the government.

Organised by BCS (Economic) Officers Association the reception was addressed by State Minister for Establishment Nurul Huda and Secretary of the Planning Ministry Dr Mohammad Harun-ar-Rashid. President of the association Rafiqul Islam presided over the function.

The Planning Minister said that after coming to power the BNP government had been mobilising 25 per cent of the Annual Development Programme (ADP) from domestic resources. Earlier there was no such contribution to the ADP during the autocratic regime when it went down to minus eight per cent.

98 pc people can't be hostages to terrors: Manik

Communist Party of Bangladesh (CPB) brought out an anti-terrorism march from the Mausoleum of Martyred Intellectuals at Mirpur yesterday which ended at the Central Shaheed Minar premises.

CPB leaders said that similar anti-terrorism marches at district levels were brought out by district CPB units.

Following the march, CPB held a rally yesterday afternoon at the Shaheed Minar premises.

It was addressed by CPB leaders — Nurul Islam Nahid and Saifuddin Ahmed Manik. Mahmuda Akhtar, mother of Jatitabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) activist Ashraf Alam Mamun who was killed early this month at the Dhaka University, also spoke on the occasion.

Mahmuda said, "My son Mamun was killed in a well planned conspiracy. She said, "The witnesses of Mamun's murder named all of the killers but only one of them was arrested so far. It clearly indicates the authority's insincerity to check terrorism."

Demanding arrest of Mamun's killers and urging collective resistance against terrorism, Mahmuda said, "Let no mother weep for her child any longer."

Saifuddin Manik said, "98 per cent of people can never be hostages to only two per cent of terrorists."

He urged all democratic forces to come forward with utmost sincerity to resist terrorism.

Nurul Islam Nahid said the terrorists were out to destroy democracy in the country and expressed his vows to continue movement in defence of democracy.

The leader also said that the Anti-Terrorism Ordinance was unnecessary because the enforcement of the existing laws could control the deteriorating law and order situation, well.

BDR seizes contrabands worth Tk 19 lakh in Rajshahi

RAJSHAHI, Sept 22: BDR personnel of 20 Rifle Battalion seized here today contrabands valued at Taka over 19 lakh and arrested two persons in this connection, reports BSS.

The smuggled goods included cow, pulse, saare, sugar, bi-cycle, cloth, blade, heroin, gold, guernsey knits, egg, chilli etc. The contrabands were deposited with the customs office and the smugglers were handed over to the police.

A total of eight cases were recorded with the police station.

Besides, a special squad of 20 Rifle Battalion led by Capt Habibur Rahman seized five belts of country made nylon guernsey knits worth about taka seven lakh raiding a bus and a train on September 20 and today.

The seized guernsey were handed over to the customs department.

Mannan leaves for London today

State Minister for Civil Aviation and Tourism Abdul Mannan leaves Dhaka today for London on way to Spain to attend a conference of the World Tourism Organization to be held in Seville, reports BSS.

Mannan will represent Bangladesh in the conference which begins on September 26, according to an official handout Tuesday.

The BEA project which has already undergone expert evaluations by national and international experts is the first private sector project in the world to be assisted by the UNDP.

It is also unique because of its hands-on services to help small and medium enterprises to improve their operational efficiency and productivity, the press release said.

However, the time schedule of group-wise test examinations will remain unchanged.

Dhaka-Pyongyang to cement ties
Bangladesh and North Korea yesterday underlined the need for consolidating the friendly ties between the two countries through proper implementation of the bilateral cultural exchange programme, signed at Pyonyong early this month, reports BSS.
