'Govt firm to implement Zia's 19-point programme'

Commerce Minister M K Anwar Thursday said that the present government was determined to implement the 19-point programme of Shaheed President Ziaur Rahman with an aim to make the country prosperous and self-reliant, reports BSS.

The primary objectives of the government are to ensure food, clothes, shelter, education, health and other basic needs for every citizen of the country, he added.

Addressing a public meeting at Goaribanga in Comilla the minister said the government had been implementing different programmes in phases for poverty alleviation, checking population boom, mass-literacy, rural electrification, supply of agricultural inputs to the farmers and construction of roads-culverts and other infrastructures for overall socio-economic development of the rural people.

Without "honest consensus" curbing of terrorism not possible: PDF

The Patriotic Democratic Front (PDF) Wednesday said that the politics of convenience of the ruling party was the only "stumbling block" to curbing violence and terrorism.

Addressing a press conference PDF leader Pankaj Bhattacharya alleged that the BNP government sometimes appeased Jamaat, sometimes Freedom Party and Jubo Command causing problem in taking action against the terrorists.

"The government has finally arrested a violence-monger Ilias Ali and raided Freedom Party office but the action is insufficient and has been taken at too late a date," the PDF leader said.

He said that the arrest of Ilias and raiding the Freedom Party office do not require promulgation of anti-terrorism ordinance. It was a matter of political will, he maintained.

Other PDF leaders including Saifuddin Ahmed Manik, Nurul Islam Nahid, Mujahidul Islam Selim, Alhaj Abdus Samad, Dilip Barua and Nirmal Biswas were present at the press conference.
