The seminar held under the auspices of Chittagong Unit of National Anti-Tuberculosis Association of Bangladesh was presided over by its President Advocate Nurul Huda. Chittagong city Mayor Mir M Nasir Uddin, Deputy Minister of Shipping Advocate A B M Zahedul Huq, Mezbahuddin Khan MP, Chittagong Medical College Principal Dr Nurun Nabi and representative of International Union Against TB and Lung Diseases (IUATLD) Dr K W H Harris also participated in the seminar. Dr Subhagata Chowdhury of Chittagong Medical College Hospital read a paper on the subject.

Dr Chowdhury said there were only ten AIDS patients in Bangladesh and one of who died recently.

BUET opens new dept: Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology has introduced a department for Petroleum and Mineral Resources Engineering, reports UNB. The department, which will offer post graduate courses in the field of petroleum and natural gas engineering, has been established under a linkage programme between the University of Alberta in Canada and BUET. Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA) has been providing financial assistance for it, said a press release. The major thrust of the linkage project is to train petroleum engineers and provide the industry with testing facilities. With the establishment of the new department, BUET will be in a better position to serve the country in the field of petroleum and natural gas engineering. Two laboratories—petro-physical and analytical laboratories with modern research and testing equipment, were formed in February, this year to facilitate the department. It is expected that the course would be started in the next session and the number of students would be limited between 10 to 15. Prof K Ikhlyar Omar has been appointed head of the department.
