

Ten-day children's camp inaugurated

Children of all ages irrespective of nationalities are always friends as they live above politics and share happiness as well as sorrows with each other, reports BSS.

This was observed by the speakers at the inaugural function of a camp in Dhaka Saturday where they also appealed the world children to forget their colours and status and stand by each other to breathe fresh air in a free atmosphere.

State Minister for Social Welfare and Women Affairs Begum Sarwari Rahman inaugurated the 10-day "32nd Children Fresh Air Excursion Camp" at the Shishu Academy auditorium in Dhaka.

"Society for children fresh air excursion camp of Calcutta, India" has organised the camp at the academy premises in cooperation with Bangladesh Shishu Kalyan Parishad.

With the parishad President Alhaj Nazir Hussain in the chair, the function was also addressed by Secretary of the Ministry Prof K M Fariduddin, Nepalese Ambassador to Bangladesh Lok Bahadur Shrestha, Deputy High Commissioner of India to Bangladesh Dr Amitava Tripathy, Director of Shishu Academy Golum Kibria, camp chief Gyan Maiti and the parishad General Secretary

Prof Bashira Mannan. Begum Sarwari Rahman welcomed the camp participants from both India and Bangladesh and hoped that their friendship would be further consolidated as they were living in democratic society in both the countries.

Speaking about present government's development programmes for children, Begum Sarwari Rahman said Shishu Academy would be established in all districts in phases to help them grow as worth citizens of the country.

Referring to the observance of the "Children Rights Week" inaugurated by Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia, Begum Rahman said the present democratic government was pledge-bound to establish children's rights to help them grow in peace and harmony.

Nepalese Ambassador Lok Bahadur Shrestha offered to hold the next camp in Kathmandu and assured that his government would ensure all facilities for successful completion of the event.

He said such camp was very helpful for developing friendship among children of the region and the world as whole.

Indian Deputy High Commissioner Dr Amitava Tripathy said the future of the SAARC would be brighter with establishment of such relations

among the countries of the region.

He said the participants of the camp would learn many things by visiting various places of Bangladesh which would help enhance their level of intellect as well as build a moral character.

The camp chief Gyan Maiti said the camp meant special for the less privileged children and it was so far held in Bhutan and Bangladesh outside India. "We want to hold it in all the SAARC countries to acquaint our children with each other," he said.

Maiti said there was no politics in it but a noble initiative to acquaint the children with a disciplined life.

The 86-member Indian group including 70 children from six to 14 years and 16 teachers and organisers led by Gyan Maiti arrived in Dhaka Friday to open the camp.

A 42-member group including 36 children of Shishu Kalyan Parishad and six individuals from Bangladesh are taking part in the camp, organisers said.

The participants will also visit various places of interest in Dhaka, Comilla, Jessore and Mymensingh during the camp period, Maiti said.

The camp will end on October 18.

5.38 lakh TV sets in country

There are five lakh thirty-eight thousand seven hundred and nine television sets in the country, Information Minister Barrister Nazmul Huda told the Jatiya Sangsad here Sunday, reports BSS.

Replying to a question of Enamul Hoq (Jamaat Cox's Bazar), the Minister said that of the total TV sets 3,70,281 were black and white sets and 1,68,428 were colour sets.

To another question by Awami League member Tabbarah Rahman Sardar (Jessore), Barrister Huda said that the receipt on account of television licence and licence renewal fees was Taka nine crore sixty-one lakh forty-two thousand seven hundred and thirty during January to September period of 1992.

The receipt on radio receiving sets licence and renewal of licence during 1991 calendar year was Taka sixty lakh two hundred and five.

He told the House that the government was examining the possibility and advisability of opening a new channel of Bangladesh television.


Alhaj Zahiruddin Ahmed died on September 6 at the age of 83.

C I Zaman passes away

Chowdhury Imamuz Zaman, tea planter and retired civil engineer, breathed his last Saturday night at his Dhanmondi residence. He was born in 1905 and hailed from Sadanabad village of Habiganj, Sylhet, says a press release.

Zaman, a gold medalist from Shibpur Engineering College, joined the Assam Engineering Service in the 1930's. After 1947, he served in the C & B in the erstwhile East Pakistan until retirement. He was associated with many philanthropic organisations.

He is survived by his wife, Begum Atiya Zaman, two sons Chowdhury Fakhruzzaman and Major Ishraq Zaman, two daughters Professor Najma Chowdhury and Tuha Zaman Ali, and seven grandchildren. He was the father-in-law of Justice Mainur Reza Chowdhury and Ambassador Syed Muazzem Ali, Salma Zaman and Major Samina Zaman. He was buried at Banani graveyard.

Bangladesh Janata Dal at a meeting Sunday called for building up resistance against the Indian attempt to push its nationals into Bangladesh, reports UNB.

The meeting held at the Gulistan Square yesterday afternoon termed it as an attempt to destabilise the country and castigated the government for what they said its failure to contain the Push-in Operation.

The speakers said it was an attack on the independence and sovereignty of Bangladesh and called upon the government to discharge its responsibility of protecting it.

Presided over by Dhaka City Convenor SM Alim, the rally was addressed, among others, by its party Chairman KM Obaidur Rahman, Secretary General Mirza Abdul Halim,

Vice President Shaheena Khan, Advocate Khan Mohammad Anwarul Wadud, Rezabuddin Chowdhury, Raziya Halim, Abul Bashar and Bablu Ahmed.

Criticising the government KM Obaidur Rahman said instead of resolving the old issues, new problems were being created by India after the Prime Minister's visit to that country.

"The subservient foreign policy and the silent diplomacy of the government are mainly responsible for the present crisis" he said adding failure of the government to settle the issues were pushing the country towards a gloomy future, he said.

Obaid also criticised the government for its failure to send back the refugee Ruhingyas to their homeland.
