The most attractive and remarkable programme of the day was the traditional flying of lighted balloons in the evening from all Buddhist monasteries.



Intestinal disorder leaves 40 dead in few days

3000 suffering from waterborn diseases

NETRAKONA, Oct 12: At least 40 people died of intestinal disorder and about 3,000 were affected by waterborn diseases in four thanas during last few days, unofficial sources said, reports UNB.

Official source, however, said only 15 people died during the period while 1,235 were attacked.

A health official told UNB, diarrhoea and dysentery broke out after the prolonged drought and unprecedented hot spell in the district. Necessary measures have

been taken to control the discases, he said. Badly affected thanas are: Purbadhala, Durgapur, Kalmakanda, Atpara and Mohangonj.
