## Serial system introduced at Aricha, Nagarbari, Doulatdia ferry ghats

Government has introduced Wednesday new serial system at Aricha, Nagarbari and Doulatdia ferry ghats of BIWTC in order to ensure proper trafficking of bus, truck and other vehicles, reports BSS.

A team of 2,000 comprising BDR, battalion police and ansar personnel under the leadership of DIG (Dhaka range) and direct supervision of DCs and SPs of Manikgonj, Rajbari and Pabna districts have already been engaged to implement the system through maintaining law and order situation.

According to this new system, every kind of vehicles have to collect serialcard from police box which is controlled by police and BIWTC authority at the entry point of ferry ghat.

Then drivers will receive a ticket from ticket counter after submitting the serial card. The name of the particular ferry to be boarded by the vehicle will be mentioned in the ticket. Any kind of money involvement for collecting serial card is strictly prohibited and deterrent measures will be taken against those who will try to violate the system.

Middlemen used to collect tolls illegally by force from drivers and vehicle-owners for a long time. The amount of tolls varying from Tk. 20 to Tk 200 per vehicle. For this reason, ferry trafficking reached at nearly stand still.

Cooperation has been sought from all quarters to maintain this serial system, introduced for the benefit of the public.

This course was a part of the experimental phase of Italian language course conducted jointly by the Italian Embassy in Dhaka and the IML.


Director of the institute Prof Abdul Haye, course teacher Prof Francesco Zannini and representative of the Italian Embassy Massari were present on the occasion.
