20,000 children get blind per yr due to vitamin-A deficiency

Deputy Leader of the House in the Jatiya Sangsad Prof A Q M Badruddoza Chowdhury in Dhaka yesterday said that about 18,000 to 20,000 children were getting blind every year due to lack of vitamin 'A', reports BSS.

Dr Chowdhury said the situation was unfortunate despite the fact that various kinds of vegetables and plants grown in the country had the highest concentration of vitamin 'A'.

He was addressing a discussion meeting arranged on the occasion of the 'World White Cane Security Day' organised by the Bangladesh Dristhithin Foundation.

The Deputy Leader of the House said there were about one million blind people in the country and the number was increasing at an alarming rate.

Presided over by Susanta Adhikari, president of the Foundation, the discussion meeting was participated by Dr Sultana Zaman, Professor of Psychology Department, Dhaka University, and Golam Mustafa, Executive Director of the Foundation.

A number of blind people reached the venue of the discussion meeting at BARC auditorium at Farmgate with white canes in their hand and listened to speakers of the function with rapt attention.

Dr Chowdhury said that there was a vast scope for undertaking integrated programmes specially in the preventive side against blindness and other forms of deformities.

Dr Chowdhury lauded the role of the Dristhithin Foundation and other non-governmental and voluntary organisations played in this regard.

Later, he gave away certificates to the winners of the essay competition organised by the foundation on the occasion of the World White Cane Security Day.

Executive Director of the foundation Ghulam Mustafa, himself a blind, demanded separate traffic rules for white canes and other types of disabled persons.

He also demanded participation of the disabled persons in the process formulating national policies for development of the disabled and deformed persons, ensuring equal opportunities in every sphere of life and removing all barriers in this regard.


29 hajis died during hajj

Govt firm to provide disabled with jobs, says Huda

Information Minister Barister Nazmul Huda said here yesterday that the present democratic government was determined to rehabilitate the blind and other disabled in the society by providing them jobs and other necessary support, reports BSS.

"We consider it our national responsibility to establish the dignity and honour of the blind and other disabled people in the social life", he added.

The minister was speaking as the chief guest at a function jointly organised by the National Disabled Development Society (NDDS) and the National Disabled Union (NDU) in observance of the 'World White Cane Day'. State Minister for Textiles Maj (Rtd) Abdul Mannan attended the function as the special guest.

Held at the NIPSOM (National Institute of Prevention and Social Medicine) auditorium, the function was also addressed, among others by Carl-Fredrik Lindstrom, consultant, special education, department of social services, Mohammad Solaiman Chowdhury, Deputy Commissioner, Dhaka, Rotarian Golam Mostafa, NDU Secretary General Jahangir Hossain, Miss Lina Tajcien Chowdhury, a blind student of Dhaka University and NDU and NDDS representatives Abdul Latif Badal, Begum Fajlatennessa. The NDDS President Sawkat Hossain Bhuyian presided.

Barrister Nazmul Huda said that the government of Begum Khaleda Zia was fully committed to rehabilitating the blind through priority programme. In this connection he said that the government was considering actively for solving the housing problem of the handicapped people of the country.

The Information Minister said that the nation could get rid of the curse of begging if the blind and other handicapped could be provided with jobs and other backing.

"The disabled are not destitutes" the minister said, adding the blind and disabled, if could be given necessary facilities could be established in social life. Most of the blinds are intelligent and efficient to shoulder any responsibility on the society, he added.

JU students halt varsity transports

A group of examinees of Jahangirnagar University yesterday halted the plying of university transports protesting postponement of their examinations.

The examinations of the first and second year honours classes were scheduled to commence from this week.

The authorities, however, at a meeting of the provosts, deans and proctor with the Vice Chancellor Prof Kazi Saleh Ahmed in the chair Tuesday postponed the examinations in view with the petitions submitted by guardians of some students.

According to guardians, their wards were feeling insecure to appear in the examinations due to a decision of Sarbodio Chhatra Otkya (SCO) that has already outlawed entry of 14 Shibir activists on the campus following September 7 incident.

Meanwhile, the first and second year honours students brought out a procession yesterday demanding immediate holding of their examinations. They also seized the keys of the university buses including those of the teachers for more than two hours to press home their demands.

Transport communication resumed following the negotiation between the Vice Chancellor and student leaders.

General Secretary of Jahangirnagar University Central Students' Union (JUCSU) Samsul Tabriz Mithu in a press release yesterday accused some teachers of postponing the examinations. Condemning the decision he said, "apart from the prevailing congenial atmosphere in the campus some teachers have made the decision of postponement to please the Jamaat Shibir forces."

He called upon all to resist the fundamentalist forces unflinchingly.

Effective steps to establish rights of blind stressed

President Abdur Rahman Biswas yesterday called for taking coordinated and effective initiatives to establish the rights of the blind people and ensure their security, reports BSS.
