

It was reported that the normal average shrimp production per acre was 50 to 200 kg. But it was also reported that the selective shrimp culture in some areas of the country through scientific method yielded per acre production from 15000 to 17000 kg last year. Government was trying its best to extend the scientific intensive shrimp culture in Khulna, Bagerhat and Satkhira coastal

The meeting decided that necessary steps such as providing loan, supply of inputs and other motivational activities to enhance the shrimp cultivation would be taken as shrimp is one of the the important foreign exchange earning sources of the country.
