One of the pioneers of country's film industry and renowned film producer-director Kazi Zahir died of heart failure at the Suhrawardi Hospital Tuesday. He was 65, reports BSS.

Kazi Zahir, after obtaining in 1961 his MA degree in Economics entered the film industry the feature film "Kakhano Asheni", which earned widespread appreciation. Better known among the films he produced and directed were "Bandhan", "Bhaiya", "Nayan-tara", "Maynamati", "Madhu Milan", "Abujh Man", "Badhu Bidaya" and "Fuler Mala" and earned reputation from the cine critics and viewers.

Dhaka, Riyadh meeting on cyclone grant tomorrow

The second joint meeting of Saudi and Bangladesh committees on cyclone grant will be held here on October 21-24, reports UNB.

The 12-member Saudi delegation will be led by Chairman of Saudi Committee Dr Abdul Aziz M Al-Turki while the Bangladesh side will be led by Enam A Chaudhury, Secretary, Economic Division and Chairman of Bangladesh Committee.

the Saudi government. This assistance was extended at the behest of the custodian of two holy mosques King Fahad bin Abdul Aziz on the request of the Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia for reconstruction of the infrastructures damaged during the last devastating cyclone.

Student commits suicide

A fifth year MBBS student of Sir Salmullah Medical College allegedly killed himself jumping from the third floor of the college hospital Tuesday morning reports UNB.

Janab Ali (26) has been suffering from mental disease for the last one week and was admitted in the hospital for treatment, hospital sources said.

He was under the care of Prof Enayatul Karim of Mental Health Care Department of the medical college.

All classes of the college have been suspended yesterday to condole the death of Janab Ali.

The statement was given jointly by movement chairman Moulana Shamsul Haq Zehadi and Hafez Ziaul Hasan Zia said that human beings were not given the right to determine who was Muslim or not.

CPB

Communist Party of Bangladesh (CPB) said that it noticed the news regarding release of Humayun Kabir and Abu Bakar Siddik - who were arrested in connection with the Ratan Sen killing and it expressed its concern that no step was taken to identify the killers of Sen although three months passed since the killing occurred.

This was stated at a meeting Tuesday presided over by Saifuddin Ahmed Manik. The meeting in a resolution demanded withdrawal of false cases against the leaders on the pro-liberation front.

BCL (B-K)

The Central President of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) and RUCSU General Secretary Ruhul Kuddus Babu and General Secretary Abdullah Kaiyum in a joint statement protested the harassment and demanded withdrawal of 'false' cases against those leaders.
