

BIDS Dr M R Khan. Prof Chowdhury underlined the need for speedy progress in all spheres of life through eradication of hunger and illiteracy and providing better health care for dignified and honourable living of each and every citizen of the country.

The Deputy Leader of the House also referred to the reforms undertaken with regard to taxes and tariff.

He said the reforms programme had helped the economy recover from the impact of the Gulf crisis, the devastating cyclone that hit the coastal belt of the country in April 1991 and problems like influx of Myanmar refugees.

He is now due to be withdrawn on November 4 and to mark the final closure of BMAT the British High Commissioner Sir Colin Imray hosted a reception at his residence on October 22, says a press release.
