30 thousand children become blind every year

The visiting President of the International Agency for the Prevention of Blindness Alan W Johns called on President Abdur Rahman Biswas at Bangabhaban yesterday, reports BSS.

They discussed matters relating to prevention of blindness through coordinated efforts.

Johns who is also Executive Director of the Royal Commonwealth Society for the blind informed that his organisation would continue to help in eradicating blindness in different countries of the world through the involvement of respective governments and the voluntary organisations.

He appreciated the endeavours of government of Bangladesh and the voluntary organisations in preventing the blindness in the country.

About 30 thousand children become blind every year in Bangladesh and national coordinated approach is going on in through providing medicare to the blinds.

President Biswas said that the present government had already undertaken a number of measures to prevent blindness in the country.

He said all should come forward to resolve the problem of blindness.

He appreciated the services of the Sight Savers in preventing blindness throughout the world.

The President said the present democratic government

laid emphasis on the humanitarian activities in a coordinated manner and sought cooperation from all the relevant international organisations in this connection.

He thanked Johns for his personal initiatives in eradicating blindness with assurance of his organisations to support and cooperation in the efforts of Bangladesh in this regard.

'Respect for law can help check terrorism'

CHITTAGONG, Oct 24: Respect for moral values and laws of the land can help check terrorism. This was the observation of the participants in a seminar on "Social responsibility in resisting terrorism" held at the Holy Crescent Hospital auditorium at Foy's Lake here under the auspices of Chittagong Chapter of Association for Correction and Social Reclamation, reports BSS.

BSFIC attains 95 pc of sugar production target: Shamsul

Industries Minister Shamsul Islam Khan yesterday asked the workers and employees of Bangladesh Sugar and Food Industries Corporation (BSFIC) to boost production for the economic emancipation, progress and prosperity of the country, reports BSS.

He was addressing as chief guest the installation ceremony of the newly elected office bearers of the Central Workers Union of the BSFIC in Dhaka yesterday at BCIC auditorium.

BSFIC chairman Meer Belayet Hossain presided the function while it was addressed, among others, by BCIC Chairman Waseque-Al Azad, BSFIC Chief of Personnel Masud Alam Siddiqui, President elect BSFIC Workers Union Abul Siddique, General Secretary elect Wadud Sharif and out-going President Abul Anwar Hossain.

The Minister said the BSFIC had attained 95 per cent of the production target of 2.18 lakh tons of sugar this year despite unfavourable conditions.

Khan said that the government would set up two more sugar mills one in Pabna and another in Strajgonj very soon.

Workshop on drama from October 29

The Drama and Film Affairs Department of the Academy has organised the workshop which will impart training on vocal and recital exercise and pronunciation.

British military advisory team ends assignment

A British military advisory team that helped Bangladesh to establish and run a Defence Services Command and Staff College over the last 15 years is going to end its assignment, reports UNB.

The last member of the British team, Captain Tony Peters of the Royal Navy, is due to leave on November 4, marking the closure of the team's work at the college which so far provided training to more 800 officers.

British High Commissioner Sir Colin Imray on Thursday evening hosted a reception here to mark the closure of the team's work in Bangladesh as well as to bid farewell to Capt. Peters.

Agriculture and Flood Control Minister Major General (Retd) Majid-ul-Haq, speaking as chief guest at the function, thanked the British government and the officers for their help and cooperation in setting up the college. He hoped that British cooperation in field of training of military officers would continue in future as well.

The function was attended among others by Chief of Army Staff Lt. General M Nooruddin Khan, Chief of Air Staff Air Vice Marshal Altaf Hossain Chowdhury, Defence Secretary MA Malik, and officers and instructors of the Defence Services Command and Staff College, Mirpur.
