only the Chittagong Hill Tracts Development Board, established in 1976, has implemented different projects with as amount of Taka 456.00 crore for the socio-economic uplistment of the tribal population of the region, with an additional allocation of Taka 263.00 crore for the special five year plan.

"The elaborate and all round infrastructure upliftment activities which look place in this region after liberation exceed the development activities of a developed country of the globe," said Chai Jhoai Roazar, a former member of parliament and a traditional tribal leader.

A like all other sectors, a revolutionary change has taken place in education sector. At present there are nine government and non-government colleges, 95 secondary schools including 33 junior high schools, 938 primary schools, nine tribal students' hostels, two residential schools with separate hostel for tribal students. In addition, training is being imparted to tribal youths once-neglected hill district of in two vocational and one technical training centres in

Rangamati and Khagrachhari in automobile, driving carpentary, electric fittings, weaving etc. About 6,000 tribal youths were trained in different trades including 1376 by BSCIC during last three years.

Earlier, there were one secondary school and 20 primary schools in this region but no college. The present literacy rate is above 50 per cent for Chakma and 20 per cent for other tribes including nontribals. The average literacy rate was about two per cent in 1947.

The tremendous development has also taken place in communication sector. Every district and thana headquarters are connected with about 760 kilometres metallic roads where as there were only 72 kilometres 'pucca' road till 1982. Every thana headquarters are also connected with telephone and district headquarters are now under nationwide direct dialling net work.

Every thana is equipped with health complexes. There are 31-bed hospitals in six thana headquarters, one 50bed hospital each in Khagrachhari and Bandarban where a 100-bed modern hospital in Rangamati. There were only a 31-bed hospital in Rangamati till 1982.

Prospect for cotton farming bright

KUSHTIA, Oct 25: Prospect for cotton cultivation in Kushtia Zone has become bright with the introduction of new variety and expansion of other facilities, according to the officials of the Cotton Development Board, reports

The zone consists of Kushtia, Chuadanga, Meherpur and Baliakandi of Rajbari district. At least 35,733 acres of land have been brought under cotton cultivation in the zone and 3,57,330 maunds of cotton seed worth Taka 27 crore is expected to be produced this year.

About 25,000 bales of lint cotton could be utilised by the textile mills of the country saving considerable amount of foreign exchange, officials said.

OOCL feeder service

Orient Overseas Container Line (OQCL) has initiated a dedicated feeder service between Chittagong and Singapore by contributing another vessel last week to a joint feeder network which commenced operations in August, says a Press release.
