Education Minister Jamiruddin Sircar yesterday said that the government was making every effort to eradicate illiteracy by the year 2000 AD, reports BSS.

Addressing as chief guest at a seminar organised by the Bangladesh National Commission for the UNESCO in Dhaka in observance of the 47th anniversary of the United Nations Day, he said illiteracy remained a curse for the nation and different programmes like the mass literacy campaign and Compulsory Primary Education were meant to attain the objective.

The minister said problems like removal of poverty and illiteracy were priority areas for the United Nations to secure a happy and healthy world and said Bangladesh with the co-operation of the world body agencies had embarked upon many a programme to eradicate illiteracy from the country.

Presided over by Education Secretary Shaiful Alam, the seminar was addressed, among others, by Chairman of the University Grants Commission Professor Shamsul Huq, Dr Ershadul Huq of Dhaka University and journalist Gias Kamal Chowdhury.

The Education Minister gave a detailed account of the emergence and evolution of the United Nations and its functioning and said the world body's achievements were a great job despite the fact that noble principles of the UN still remained unfulfilled.

He referred to Bangladesh's role in the United Nations and said the very fact that Dhaka was elected a member of the Security Council in 1978 during the time of late President Ziaur Rahman was a testimony of the respect it enjoyed in the comity of nations.

Shamsul Huq said the world remained afflicted by tensions and conflicts today although progress had been made to-

### Biman passengers not supplied with 'Janata' for low circulation

Biman passengers are not supplied with Dainik Janata because of the daily 'low circulation and reader apathy', State Minister for Civil Aviation and Tourism Abdul Mannan told parliament yesterday, reports UNB.

Replying to Raushan Ali (AL-Jessore), the State Minister said newspapers were supplied to passengers on the basis of their circulation and readers' demand.

Several opposition members, particularly a number of Jatiya Party members, protested when the minister said that circulation of Janata is one-tenth of Dainik Ittefaq which has a circulation of 2,15,000.

Mannan also informed the House that circulation of Inqilab was 1,70,000, Banglar Bani 1,14,000, Dainik Bangla 64,000 and Janata 10,000.

JP leader Moudud Ahmed instantly rose in protest, saying that the minister's figures were "untrue" and not scientific.

He said circulation of Janata was five times higher than that of Dainik Dinkal, Dainik Bangla and Bangladesh Times.
