Infrastructural facilities to be provided to youths: President

President Abdur Rahman Biswas yesterday called for building the country's youth forces as competent to meet the challenges of the present competitive world, reports BSS.
 Referring to the present government's initiatives on human resources development programme and production oriented activities, the President said the youth community would be integrated in these programmes for enabling them to contribute their mites in nation building pursuits.
 Infrastructural facilities will be provided to the youth community in phases, he said.
 He stressed the need for expansion of technology-based education for the youths and utilising them in the development activities for overall progress of the country.
 The President said this when a youth delegation of Bangladesh Social Welfare Organisation led by its Chairman Abul Hasanat called on him at Bangabhaban.
 President Biswas referred to the National Youth Day being observed throughout the country yesterday and said the youth community should be absorbed in the development activities by establishing more small and cottage industries in the country.
 "This will help those youths who are living in the rural areas to become self-reliant," he said adding that the national economy would also see a boost up with utilisation of the potentiality of the youth forces in national development activities.
 President Biswas called upon the youth community to help maintain peace and discipline in all spheres of life and put in their best efforts in the self-income generating programmes.

Drugs seized, 23 arrested

A special squad of the Narcotics Control Department seized a sizeable amount of illegal drugs and arrested 23 persons in this connection from various places of the city during the last eight days, reports BSS.
 The squad yesterday conducted a raid at Satmasjid area on a tip-off an arrested two notorious drug dealers with 50 grams of heroin the arrested persons Micheal Das and Md Atahar Ali have long been involved in this trade.
 The squad in its raids conducted at Rothkhola, Kawran Bazar and Tejgaon areas from October 25 to 31 and seized a total of 50 grams of heroin, 5.3 kgs of ganja, 15 grams of hashish and arrested 21 persons in this connection.

State Minister for Relief Lutfar Rahman Khan yesterday said that the service clubs could play an important and vital role to help the distressed and afflicted people of the country, reports BSS.
 He was speaking at the inaugural function of 'Civitan Bangladesh Convention-92' held at a local hotel.
 Munzur-e-Aziz, president of Civitan Bangladesh, Dr J F Burney, president-elect of Civitan International USA, W John Rynearson, executive vice president of Civitan International and Md Suhrah Ali, Professor of Institute of Post Graduate Medicine and Research, spoke on the occasion.
 The State Minister said, Bangladesh is one of the most densely populated countries in the world. He said the Bangladesh development scenario is dominated by meagre natural endowment, low level of literacy, under-developed human resources and skills, slow pace of economic development and rapid growth of population.
 Khan said, Shaheed President Ziaur Rahman identified the problems with his vision and perception and developed a correct plan of action for poverty alleviation through self-help schemes and village-based work programme. The key element in his 19-point programmes was self-help and people's participation, he added.
 Terming the last year's devastating cyclone and tidal surge unprecedented the State Minister said, "With our combined efforts, sincerity and dedication we can withstand natural calamities."

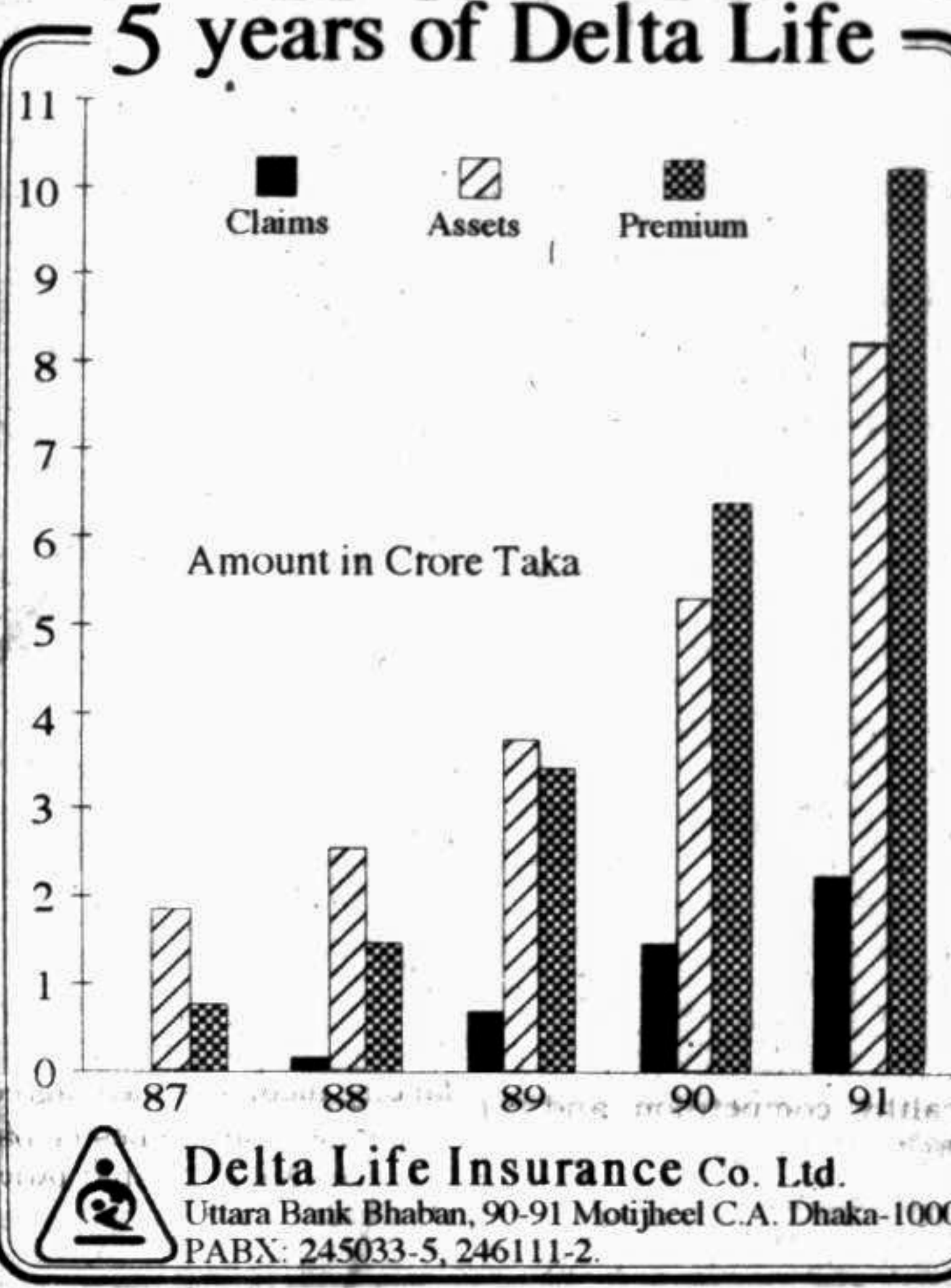
Painting Exhibition
