Applications are invited from Bangladesh Nationals for the position of National Financial Consultant under a UNDP Supported Project "Monitoring and Analysis of External Debt" BGD 88/058. The Terms of Reference (TOR) of this consultancy are as under.

Duties:

- Act as counterpart of the CTA and assist the DFABA personnel in collecting, compiling and preparing data for using the DMFAS filling up forms, calculation of debt transactions and keeping books of accounts for the preparation of debt budget/statements as appropriate.
- Assist the computer personnel in changing/up dating where necessary the existing debt files for debt monitoring in IBM system 34 and for correlating the data into the DMFAS for better debt management.
- Provide government authorities necessary assistance in the area of external debt management and within the scope of the project specially in reconciling, calculating and projecting present debt liabilities and future debt service liabilities of the Government.
- Assist in the establishment of a computerized debt monitoring and reporting system in ERD.
- Training of DFABA and computer personnel in using DMFAS in collaboration with the Expatriate consultants Computer Programmes.
- Assist government authority for setting up of a central debt unit in the ERD and generating required information/data for preparing national debt policy of the Government.

Duration: 2 (Two) Years.

Qualification: The consultant must have a Doctorate degree in Economics, Finance or a Chartered Accountant from a recognized University/Professional Institutes, or a high academic degree with appropriate training and may be a member of a consulting firm, having experience in the related field. A minimum of 8 Years practical experience in the analysis of public and private financial debt accounts and at least five Years experience in the capacity of a consultant of the Government/Semi-government/private organization. Platform for youths under SAARC umbrella urged

Planning Minister A M Zahiruddin Khan yesterday called for establishing a platform for the youth under the umbrella of SAARC to deal with problems of the fledgling generation of the region, reports UNB.

Inaugurating a regional workshop on youth development, he said negligence of youth in developing countries like Bangladesh would cause harm to national progress.

Dwelling on overall situation of the youth in this region, Khan urged the policymakers and political leaders to work for development of human resources.

The youth should behave and act responsibly and conscientiously and not work as appendices of political parties, he advised.

Terming the youth as vital force of the country, he urged them to analyse the political environment and play due role as conscience of the nation.

The workshop on "Promotion and Development of Youth Organisations" was organised jointly by the Department of Youth Development, the Ministry of Youth and Sports and the Bureau of NGO Affairs in collaboration with Commonwealth Youth Programme, Asia Centre and Ford Foundation.

Held at the Hotel Purbani, the inaugural function was also addressed by State Minister for Sports Sadeq Hossain, Additional Secretary to the Ministry of Youth and Sports, Mohammad Nazrul Islam, Regional Director, CYP, Asia Centre, India, Devendra Agochiya, DG of the Bureau of NGO Affairs F R Chowdhury and DG of the Department of Youth Development Zainul Abedin.

About 24 delegates from Pakistan, India, Sri Lanka, Maldives, Malaysia, Hong Kong, Brunei and the host Bangladesh are participating in the workshop.

Organisers said they would review the nature and problems of each country and recommend guidelines to promote skill development programmes through exchange of views and ideas.

The Planning Minister also stressed the need for a transparent, accountable leadership to guide the young generation on right track.

"Unless we establish true leadership and fail to guide the youth properly, socio-economic development of the country can never be achieved."

Referring to inadequate resources and weak structural supports as the reasons for our youth lagging behind, the minister urged the political leaders and concerned authorities to play due role in upholding their cause.

Devendra Agochiya in his speech urged the youth not to be exploited by political parties.

F R Chowdhury said about three million unemployed youth were being added to the country's population every year, and most of them are illiterate, unskilled and suffering from malnutrition and frustration.

Director General of the Department of Youth Development Lt Col (Rtd) Mohammad Zainul Abedin called for mobilising the youth for productive purpose and turn them into vehicles for sustainable socio-economic development.

'Women subjected to oppression everywhere'

Bangladesh Press Council Chairman Justice Sultan Hossain Khan yesterday urged the women organisations to come forward for social, economic and mental development of the country's women folk, reports BSS.

Addressing the second annual conference of the Bangladesh Mahila Forum as the chief guest at the National Press Club auditorium, Justice Khan said the women, constituting half of the country's population, were neglected everywhere and subjected to oppression.

Presided over by President of the organisation Ferdousi Sultana, the conference was also addressed by Vice-President of the Bangladesh Federation of University Women Munira Khan, President of the Women's Voluntary Association Shilu Abed and General Secretary of the Mahila Forum Ashrafunnesa Rosy.

The union also expressed their heartfelt sympathy for the members of the bereaved family and prayed for the salvation of the departed soul.

BSRS earns Tk 7.83 cr pre-tax profit

Bangladesh Shilpa Rin Sangstha (BSRS) earned a pre-tax profit of Tk 7.83 crore during the fiscal year 1991-92 as against Tk 6.66 crore in 1990-91, reports UNB.

Managing Director, BSRS Mamun-ur-Rashid disclosed the figure while presenting the Annual Report to the shareholders of BSRS at its 6th annual general meeting held at its head office in Dhaka yesterday.

The meeting was presided over by Dr Abdullah Faruk, Chairman, Board of Directors of BSRS.

The shareholders reviewed current loan recovery position legal actions against the willful defaulters, rehabilitation and revitalisation of sick and non-performing projects.

The meeting also discussed the privatisation process of BSRS for which a public limited company — Development Bank Ltd — was launched on September 14.

The meeting was informed that appointment of a suitable manager for the company is in the process. A prospectus for sale of shares will be duly published in the national dailies.

The shareholders also approved the appointments of two reputed chartered accountants firm for auditing the Annual Accounts of BSRS for FY 1992-93.
