Setting up of data bank stressed

Planning Minister A M Zahiruddin Khan yesterday said that setting up of a data bank had become essential to remove the information gap that existed among the policy makers of the country, reports BSS.

In this age of faster technological changes only the data bank could help the policy makers to adopt proper and suitable technology for the country, Khan said while addressing the inaugural function of a two-day training workshop on "Leadership style" organised by the Institute of Diploma Engineers.

The Minister said he would personally initiate the concept of setting up the data bank at the Planning Commission for use of the policy makers and planners.

Moniruzzaman to join assignment next month

Former Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University Moniruzzaman Mian who has been appointed the country's Ambassador to Senegal, in expected to join his assignment early next month.

"As diplomat, I look forward to serving the nation in a wider area," said Moniruzzaman who dedicated his life in teaching profession for 34 years.

"I shall try my best to enhance the image and prestige of the country abroad," he said while talking to UNB at the Foreign Office today.

Prof Moniruzzaman apparently took delight in the new assignment when he recalled his days in the violence-torn campus of Dhaka University.

He began his career as a teacher of Jagannath college in 1958. He joined Dhaka university in 1966 and continued there till appointment as ambassador on October 31, 1992.

A bachelor Prof Moniruzzaman was born at Jangipur in Murshidabad, West Bengal in 1935. He obtained masters degree in, geography from Rajshahi University.

Seminar on water and environment
Need for construction of water reservoir stressed

RAJSHAHI, Nov 12: A seminar on "Water and environment" organised by the Institution of Engineers, Bangladesh, Rajshahi centre was held here yesterday, reports BSS.

Presided over by Engineer Mazharul Islam, the seminar was addressed, among others, by the Chief Whip in the Jatiya Sangsad Khandakar Delwar Hossain, State Minister for Law and Justice Barrister Aminul Huq, Rajshahi City Corporation Mayor Mizanur Rahman Minu, Azizur Rahman, MP, Lutfunnessa Hossain, MP and Engineer Abdul Momen.

Engineer M Asaduzzaman, Executive Director, Barendra Multipurpose Development Authority (BMDA) presented the keynote paper at the seminar.

The speakers expressed their concern over the deteriorating environmental problem in the region due to adverse effect of Farakka. They stressed the need for construction of water reservoir in different areas for preservation of monsoon water for use in the dry season.

They also called upon all to extend their cooperation to canal digging programme of the government as it would also help water preservation.

Asaduzzaman said that BMDA has so far planted forty-nine lakh saplings in Barendra region for maintaining ecological balance.

The speakers said Farakka was not only creating ecological imbalance in the region but also hampering the environmental and socio-economic problem of the country.

They said "Water and environmental problem" created by Farakka should be resolved by both Bangladesh and India as per SAARC spirit.

"We want good and friendly relations with our all neighbours including India with equal sovereignty" they added.

Khandakar Delwar Hossain said our rivers loose navigation and salinity in southern areas of the country increases due to adverse effect of Farakka Barrage. He said bilateral talks between the present democratic government and India were being held for mutual solution of sharing of river waters.

Presenting the key-note paper Asaduzzaman said average annual rainfall in Barind area in 1991 was 64 inches which was 54 inches in 1985.
