University of Science Technology to begin academic session Jan '93

CHITTAGONG, Nov 14: University of Science and Technology, Chittagong, a full-fledged private university of the country, will begin its academic session from January next with the faculties of Medicine and Basic Pharmaceutical Science to cater to the need of medical practitioners, reports BSS.

National Professor Nurul Islam told newsmen at the Institute of Allied Health Science (IAHS) Auditorium at Foyez Lake here today that the university was affiliated by the government on November 9 under the Private University Act of 1992.

The university will gradually open faculties of business studies, social sciences and faculty of agriculture. With the aim of meeting this requirement to some extent Prof Islam founded the IAHS, a private medical college in May 13, 1989 of which he is the chairman.

The Private Medical Institute having about 220 students will be included in the new university, he said.

Prof Islam said the major advantage is that the private university could be able to prescribe strict rules for maintaining discipline and conducting examinations in order to avoid session jams, strike and violence. It will be the university's responsibility to pay for the students' education for any year lost on account of national catastrophe, he added.

Re-union of Journalism Dept session 1970-74 held

The students of the Department of Journalism and Mass Communication, University of Dhaka, for the session 1970-1974, held a re-union with a difference on Friday recollecting their bygone youthful days of intense nationalist movement and War of Liberation, reports BSS.

"The friends of the seventies," as they called themselves, met for the first time at the lush green compound of the TSC and spent several hours recollecting their memorable days.
