Mobilise resources to minimise impacts of global warming: Biswas

President Abdur Rahman Biswas Monday called for mobilisation of enormous resources and adoption of appropriate technology for minimising the socio-economic impacts of global warming, reports BSS.

He said it is imperative to make coordinated efforts to accommodate more concepts and ideas on global warming and sea rise problems confronted by the people of the coastal region.

The President was inaugurating a four-day workshop on "Impact of rise in sea level due to global warming for the South Asian region" at the National Museum auditorium in Dhaka. Organised by the National Oceanographic and Maritime Institute (NOAMI), the inaugural session of the workshop was chaired by its Chief Advisor and founder-Chairman Rear Admiral (Retd) M H Khan. It was also addressed by Vice-Chairman of the Inter-governmental Oceanographic Commission (IOC) Dr G S Quraishee.

The workshop is being attended by representatives from India, Maldives, Pakistan, Sri Lanka and the IOC besides the host Bangladesh. The President stressed the

need for preparation and activation of integrated programme according to the needs and requirements of the hour.

The President said the southern region of Bangladesh is highly prone to frequent natural disasters like cyclones, storm surges, coastal erosion and floods which, however, are mostly short-lived phenomena but the losses incurred by them in terms of life and property are enormous, he added.

President Biswas said we have nothing to be frustrated about but to be optimistic in resolving the warming problem by knowing the consequences of the phenomenon. We should have to be conscious in utilising our resources with intelligence and invest our available resources into research activities, he advised.

The President said environment and development are interlinked.
