
The demands were endorsed by an extended meeting of JKP held on Sunday with its chief Strajul Hossain Khan in the chair, a press release said yesterday.

One gets 10-yr RI for possessing illegal arms

CHITTAGONG, Nov 23: The Additional Sessions Judge, Third Court (Special Tribunal) Mofizul Islam on Sunday sentenced Pintu Kumar Das of Anowara Thana to ten years Rigorous Imprisonment for possessing illegal fire arms and fined him Taka two thousand, in default to suffer imprisonment for three months more, reports BSS.

The prosecution story is that Pintu Das and some unknown persons were waiting in a baby taxi on Kaptai road near Patiyapara of Rauzan Thana on June 6, 1988. A police squad challenged the passengers of the baby taxi on suspicion. Pintu Kumar Das and his companions then tried to flee away, but Pintu Das was caught with a rocket launcher in front of some local people.

The judge examined several witnesses of the case and found Pintu Kumar Das guilty under Special Power Act. Pintu Das hails from Anowara Thana of Chittagong.
