President for using modern technology in sea resources

President Abdur Rahman Biswas yesterday underscored the need for using modern technology and equipment for maximum utilisation of the country's sea resources, reports BSS.

Five pirates held, arms recovered
KHULNA, Nov 26: A patrol-craft of the Bangladesh Navy this morning arrested four pirates and recovered one pipe gun, four cartridges and other weapons like chopper, dagger and iron bar from them, says a press release.

The Bangladesh Navy Ship Pabna arrested the pirates re-handled from the mouth of the river Bishkhali on a mechanised boat.

Earlier, a patrol team of the BN personnel seized two country boats and recovered 23 empty barrels and some nylon rope stolen from a foreign merchant ship which were later returned to the foreign ship. They also arrested Nurul Islam, a notorious pirate of Chhila Bazar under Bagerhat district for his involvement in the theft.

Live cricket on Star TV
Star TV's 24-hour sports channel, Prime Sports, will follow the entire South Africa, India Test series from start to finish including live coverage of the seven one-day internationals in December and daily highlights of the four Test matches, two in November and two in January, says a Star TV press release from Hong Kong.

Sunil Gavaskar, the top run scorer in the history of cricket, will join Prime Sports' live broadcasts, providing commentary from each of the one-day internationals. He will be speaking to Brian Langley, who will host the epic series from Star TV's Hong Kong studio. Gavaskar captained India through 47 Test series, batting for 10,122 runs at an average of 51.12.
