Third world govts urged to increase funds for science, technology

Establishment of a network of international and regional centres of science, technology and environment was unanimously endorsed at the General Conference of the Third World Academy of Science, which concluded in Kuwait on Thursday, reports UNB.

This was stated by Energy and Mineral Resources Minister Dr Khandaker Mosharraf Hossain while talking to newsmen at his residence yesterday after his return from Kuwait attending the four-day conference (November 23-26).

A ministerial level meeting during the conference also recommended the third world countries to extend cooperation among themselves for sustainable development in the field of science and technology.

The Minister said that the meeting called on the South to increase its scientific manpower to receive cooperation from the North to cope with the advancement of science and technology in the 21st century.

It recognised that from 21st century, the competition will be on science and technology for the survival of the nations.

Importance was also given at the meeting, he said, to form a South-South platform to create an environment for North-South cooperation.

The governments of third world countries were urged to increase allocations for science and technology up to 2 per cent of their budget to achieve the objective of increasing scientific manpower.

Dr Mosharraf, in his address at the general conference of the academy, proposed setting up of an international centre for science, technology and environment in Dhaka to benefit the densely populated regions of the third world.

Delegations from 72 countries, including 18 ministers, attended the fourth General Conference of the Third World Academy of Science, organised by the Kuwait Foundation of the Advancement of Sciences.

The Energy Minister, during his stay in Kuwait, also visited the areas where Bangladesh army personnel were engaged in helping the war-shattered economy of the tiny Gulf state.

The performance of Bangladesh Army was highly praised by all in Kuwait. They have done a tremendous job there and increased the image of the country, he said.

Different organisations and political parties held discussion meetings in observance of the second death anniversary of Dr Shamsul Alam Khan Milon in the city yesterday.

The Dhaka Medical College Teachers' Association (DMCTA) and the DMC Central Students Union (DMCCSU) jointly held a discussion at the college premises in the morning.

Jute Minister Brig (ret) Hannan Shah, addressing the meeting as chief guest, announced that the government would formulate a pro-people health policy in consultation with the Bangladesh Medical Association (BMA).

President of DMCTA Prof. Goushan Ali called upon all concerned to work sincerely for materialising the ideals of Dr Milon.

Terming the government steps inadequate she said that the DMC should take initiative to achieve the goal.

Addressing the meeting at the PG hospital auditorium Works Minister Barrister Rafiqul Islam Mia yesterday said that the trial of Milon's killers was not held properly because a powerful political party provided shelter to them.

The minister attended the discussion titled "Physicians role in developing democracy" as chief guest organised by Bangladesh Private Medical Practitioners' Association, Dhaka metropolitan wing.

The meeting presided over by Dr Fakhrul Islam Chowdhury was addressed, among others, by State Minister for Civil Aviation and Tourism Abdul Mannan as special guest, Chief Whip of the Parliament Khandkar Delwar Hossain, Joint Director of PG Institute Md Tahir, Editor of Daikin Bangla Bazar Mottur Rahman Chowdhury, and BPMPA General Secretary Dr C M Dilwar Rana.

Patriotic Democratic Front (PDF) held a discussion in the city to mark Milon's death anniversary.

The meeting presided over by Pankaj Bhattacharya was addressed, among others, by Nurul Islam Nahid, Dilip Barua, Al-hajj Abdus Samad and Imdadur Rahman.

Demanding retrial of the killers of Dr Milon, the leaders demanded a terrorism-free democratic society.
