Students rally accuses Shibirites of attempt to stage communal riots

Student leaders backed by different political parties accused the Jamaat-Shibir circle of its attempt to organise a 'communal riot' in the country centering the incident of demolition of Babri Mosque in Ayodhya.

This was stated at the Dhaka University campus by the student leaders on the eve of a peace procession yesterday.

Sixteen student organisations in the country yesterday jointly brought out a grand peace procession from the Dhaka University campus calling for maintenance of communal harmony across the country.

The student leaders urged

the government and people to take necessary steps against the fundamentalists to keep communal stability in the country.

The student organisations include the pro-Awami League Chhatra League (M-I), JSD (Inu) backed Chhatra League (B-K), Samajtantrik Chhatra Front, Chhatra Oikya Forum (Mishu), Bangladesh Chhatra Union, Bangladesh Chhatra Mofree, Bangladesh Chhatra Federation.

The students held a rally at the Aparajeeo Bangla of the Dhaka University at about 11 am before beginning the procession.

ECNEC okays two projects worth Tk 162.45 crore

The government approved yesterday two development projects involving Tk 218.29 crore with a foreign exchange component of Tk 162.45 crore, reports UNB.

The approval came at a meeting of the Executive Committee of the National Economic Council (ECNEC) held in the Secretariat cabinet room with Finance Minister M Saifur Rahman in the chair.

The ECNEC meeting also took a few important decisions pertaining to disinvestment process as per the proposals made by the interministerial privatisation committee.

According to an official handout, the approved projects are the revised project of the post-1991 cyclone damaged railway rehabilitation under Railway Division of the

Communication Ministry and approval of additional sanction for completion of the ongoing second flood rehabilitation project 1988, assisted by Asian Development Bank under the Ministry of Agriculture, Irrigation, Water Development and Flood Control.

Agriculture, and Irrigation, Water Development and Flood Control Minister M Majid-ul Haq, Industries Minister M Shamsul Islam Khan, Post and Telecommunication Minister M Keramat Ali, Commerce Minister M K Anwar, Planning Minister A M Zahuruddin Khan, Cabinet Secretary, Principal Secretary to the Prime Minister, Governor of Bangladesh Bank and other concerned high officials were present in the meeting.
