5-party asks govt to compensate affected minority

Central five-party alliance at a meeting yesterday demanded of the government to compensate and rehabilitate those who were affected by the violence in the country following the destruction of Babri Mosque.
They also demanded the renovation of the damaged temples in the country.

Chaired by the five-party alliance Convenor Khalequzzaman Bhuiyan the meeting was attended by Nirmal Sen, Sharif Nurul Ambia, Bimal Biswas and AFM Mahbulul Haq.
Bangladesh Jubo Union leaders in a separate statement yesterday called upon the government and the opposition political organisations to rehabilitate the members of the minority community affected in the incident.

The statement jointly issued by the union Chairman MD Hilal Uddin, Deputy Chairman Subrata Chowdhury and Secretary General BA Rashid protested the communal uproar in the country.
The also resented the government's failure in ensuring safety to the members of the minority community and demanded arrest of those involved in the disturbances.

Hydrostaticist dies of heart attack
Abdur Rahman, a former Director of the Hydraulic Research Institute, also a noted hydrostaticist aged 75, died of a heart attack at his Lalmatia residence here yesterday morning, reports BSS.
Rahman was also a part time advisor to the Bangladesh Water Development Board.
He left behind his wife, one daughter, a son and a host of admirers to mourn his death.
The Namaz-e-Janaza was held at Bibr Mosque after the Asr prayer and buried at Mirpur Shaheed Intellectual graveyard.
Qul khwan of Rahman will be held on December 22 after Asr prayer at his Lalmatia residence at 4/8, Block-D.

Strengthen Prime Minister's hand to consolidate democracy: Huda

75 pc under five suffer from malnutrition

Speakers at a seminar yesterday said 75 per cent of country's children under five suffered from malnutrition which is congenital in most cases, reports UNB.
Fifty per cent of the children are born underweight because of their mothers' malnutrition, illiteracy and lack of awareness of healthcare, they said.
The "Motivational Seminar of Health Care" was organised by the Inner Wheel Club of Metropolitan in the WVA auditorium. It was inaugurated by Latifa Kamal, District Chairman of the club.
Leading specialist Prof Nazmun Nahar, department of Paediatric, DMCH, Dr Sofia Rahman, Heart Specialist, Cardiovascular Institute, Dr Suriya Rahman, Chief of the Gynecology Department of CMII, and Dr Jahannara Alauddin, Chief of the Intensive Care Unit, Shishu Hospital, led the discussion in their respective field and expertise.
Dr Suriya Rahman said percentage of safe delivery in the country is only 5 and informed the seminar that measures would be taken to reach the target of 40 per cent by 1995.
Out of the total 40 lakh childbirths per year, high risk delivery is about 6 lakh. Some 23,000 mothers die each year owing to complications in childbirth, the seminar was told.

66 held on various charges

Police rounded up 66 people from different parts of the city in last 24 hours on various charges, a DMP press release said yesterday, reports UNB.
Of the arrested, eight were wanted criminals, one on charge of murder, five accused in arms cases, two charged with robbery, eight for burglary and nine for stealing.

Bangladesh National Museum and Japanese Embassy here jointly organised the exhibition at the National Museum auditorium.
Director General of National Museum Shaikh Akram Ali and Japanese Ambassador to Bangladesh Toshio Saiki addressed the inaugural function.
A total of 183 photographs of 58 Japanese photographers were on display in the exhibition.

Demolition of tombstone of Liberation War martyrs protested

RAJSHAHI, Dec 19: Several hundred teachers, students and employees of the Rajshahi University today (Saturday) staged demonstration and brought out a procession protesting the demolition of tombstone of a mass grave of the martyrs of Liberation War, reports UNB.
The tombstone laid on December 16 last behind the Zoha Hall of the university endeavoured by Rajshahi University Central Students Union (RUCSU) but demolished by unknown miscreants the same night.
Held at TSC square, the demonstration blamed Jamaat-Shibir for the incident and demanded exemplary punishment to those responsible.
It was addressed by teachers and student leaders including Prof Shamsur Rahman of Social Science Department and RUCSU pro-VP Kader Sarker.
