BPC examining feasibility of Tk12 cr project in Mongla, Sundarban

Bangladesh Parjatan Corporation (BPC) is examining the feasibility of taking up a Taka 12 crore project in the Mongla and Sundarban areas for the promotion of tourism under its three year plan, reports BSS.

This was revealed in the 10th meeting of parliamentary standing committee on the Ministry of Civil Aviation and Tourism held at the Jatiya Sangsad Bhaban here yesterday.

Presided over by the Chairman of the committee, Minister of State for Tourism Abdul Mannan, the meeting was attended by Jatiya Sangsad members Shah Haiduzzaman, Sheikh Fazlul Karim Selim, Ataur Rahman Khan, Begum Rahima Khondkar, Alam Khan, Saiful Azam, Syed Murshed Kamal, Secretary of the Minister Habibur Rahman and BPC Chairman, M A R Talukdar.

They pleaded for making adequate publicity about the tourism facilities in the country to attract tourists both from home and abroad.

'Better disaster management can help reduce loss of lives'

State Minister for Relief Lutfar Rahman Khan yesterday said better disaster management could substantially reduce the loss of lives and damage to property during natural disasters, reports BSS.

He was addressing as chief guest the certificate awarding ceremony of the workshop on Disaster Management at the seminar hall of the Institution of Engineers.

Organised by the International University of Business, Agriculture and Technology (IUBAT), the function was addressed by IUBAT

management programme Advisor Prof Dr Abdur Rab, participant Harun-ar-Rashid and President of the IUBAT Prof Dr M Alimullah Miyan.

The workshop began on November 21 and it was participated by 15 persons from different government and non-government organisations.

The State Minister said at present disaster management is a crying need of Bangladesh as it plays a very vital role in development efforts of the country.

Describing Bangladesh as a highly disaster prone country,

the State Minister said the availability of expert knowledge, trained personnel, technical back-up and information sharing were major constraints of appropriate preparedness, response and mitigation to disasters.

He said the present government was aware of the critical need in disaster management and has already designated the ministry of relief for coordination and development efforts.

Earlier, Khan distributed certificates among the participants.

Farmers' participation in BWDB projects sought

A high-level meeting was held at the Conference Room of Irrigation Ministry on massive participation and motivation of the farmers of the command area of irrigation schemes and to find out a suitable policy to involve the local farmers into the process of designing, implementing and maintenance of the irrigation, drainage and flood control projects of Bangladesh Water Development Board (BWDB), reports BSS.

Agriculture and Irrigation, Water Development and Flood Control Minister M Majid-ul-Haq presided over the meeting. The meeting was attended, among others, by Irrigation Secretary M Asafuddinwah and Chairman of BWDB MA Razzak.

The meeting discussed in

detail the attitudes and intentions of the people of irrigation scheme command areas and decided to undertake suitable project which will be more viable and acceptable by the people. One killed in road mishap

One person was killed and two others injured when a speeding bus knocked an auto rickshaw over Dholaipar Bridge in the city at about 4.15 Monday.

The victims were identified as Mohammad Shariat Ullah, 24 Mohammed Murad Sarkar (24), and Mohammed Zamil Hossain (22).

They were seriously injured and immediately rushed to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) where doctors on duty declared Shariat Ullah dead. Among the injured Murad was admitted to the DMCH in a critical condition, while Zamil was released after first aid.

Police sent the body of the victim to the DMCH morgue for autopsy.

Police seized the bus. The driver managed to escape.
