Country-made ferry starts functioning

The country entered into a new era with successful assembling of a modern ferry by Danish grant and technical assistance.

The assembled ferry named after Shaheed Birshrestha Jahangir was formally handed over to the Bangladesh Inland Water Transport Corporation (BIWTC) authorities by the Danish Charge d' Affaires Thursday which also started operating between Aricha and Nagarbari Thursday.

It took 26 months to complete assembling of the ferry at a Narayanagar dockyard, which has a capacity of carrying 28 trucks and buses, the source said adding it cost Tk 22 crore 78 lakh.

Bangladesh and Denmark signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) in 1990 providing for a grant to assemble two ferries here.

The second one is expected to be completed by early February, the source said.

With the new one the number of BIWTC ferry rose to 29, of which 23 were operating in Aricha-Nagarbari and Aricha-Dauldia route.

More than 2,000 vehicles are ferried through these two routes daily.

Handing over the documents, Danish Charge d' Affaires K K Neilson, in a simple ceremony at the BIWTC head office, said "this transfer of technology will be helpful for Bangladesh" and promised further Danish help.

"It is a Christmas gift for the people of Bangladesh from Danish government," Neilson said.

Salam seeks BNP leadership in development activities

LGRD and Cooperatives Minister Barrister Abdus Salam Talukder yesterday underscored the need for leadership of the government in the development activities of the country side by side with the strengthening of the private sector, reports BSS.

Inaugurating a day-long workshop on organisational structure and functions of the Ministry of Planning at the NEC Auditorium here, Barrister Talukder, who is also the Chairman of the Parliamentary Standing Committee on the Ministry of Planning, said that efforts were being made to reduce the public sector and develop the private sector in view of the dramatic changes in the world economy.

Bangladesh could not keep itself away from the dramatic changes in the world after the fall of socialist economy in Soviet Union and Eastern Europe, the Minister said and added, following such changes Bangladesh was trying to introduce "market economy" in the country by weakening the public sector.

But he pointed out that the private sector including the agriculture sector could not be reorganised and sound till now. Besides, he said, Bangladesh has resource constraints and lack of infrastructure, therefore government's role was significant in a developing country like Bangladesh.

Planning Minister A M Zahiruddin Khan addressed the inaugural session of the parliamentary Standing Committee on the Ministry of Planning and senior officials of the concerned ministries and departments.

The LGRD Minister said that the main objectives of the present democratic government were to engage itself in removing poverty, control of population growth, spread of education.

Speedy disposal of road-accident cases urged

Communications Minister Oli Ahmed yesterday called upon the district administration to take steps for quicker disposal of the road-accident cases and check encroachment in railway lands and lands owned by Roads and Highways Department, reports BSS.

The Minister was addressing an evening session on the last day of the two-day conference of the Deputy Commissioners of the country at the cabinet committee room of Bangladesh Secretariat here.

The Minister thanked the Deputy Commissioners for the positive role they played to foil the illegal transport strike.

Cabinet Secretary, Principal Secretary to the Prime Minister and Roads and Road Transport Secretary and the Divisional Commissioners were present.

Hawkers threaten movement

Dhaka Newspaper Hawkers Union at a meeting Wednesday threatened to go for a greater movement if the probe report on 'Sangbadpatra Hawkers Kalyan Bahumukhi Samabadi Samity' was not implemented by 15 days.

The meeting alleged that the said organisation formed with some non-professionals would create anarchy.

The meeting presided over by its president Lutfi Ali was addressed, among others, by Abu Siddique, Abdul Hye Bhuiyan, Abdul Awal, Lal Mia, Enayetullah, Mofazzal Huq, Abul Kalam, Kazi Manir Ahmed and M A Sattar. General Secretary Mostafa Kamal conducted the meeting.
