**President's speech in JS**

The President said, efforts for meeting the increasing demand for electricity reducing system loss and expanding rural electrification were on. Work to provide electricity facilities to different police stations is continuing under Rural Electrification Board. Measures to supply electricity to another 160 thanas will be taken very soon. The system loss in electricity sector has reduced.

Policies have been adopted to allow expansion of electricity under private sector along with government initiatives, he said.

A special initiative has been taken to explore country's mineral resources and programmes have been taken to explore gas and oil by utilising our own resources and technology, he added. Preliminary work for exploring gas in Bholia has been taken.

Initiatives have been taken to implement two LPG production projects to supply liquefied petroleum gas to areas where there is no gas as well as to increase supply of gas. Efforts are continuing to implement hard rock project in Madya Para. The development programme of coal field in Barapukuria is successfully going ahead, the President pointed out.

President Biswas said, work on the Taka 2,500 crore Jamuna Multipurpose Bridge Project had been taken up on priority basis to establish proper communications network with the western region of the country. This bridge will include facilities for railways, gas, electricity and telecommunications.

President Biswas told the House that by now, 830 kilometre road development, one thousand four hundred metre bridge and culverts, and 900 metres bailey bridges had been built. Work on development of 175 km road and 2,500 metre bridges have been going on. Losses have been substantially reduced under the restoration programme of the Bangladesh Railway.

The losses of the Bangladesh Railway stood in 1991-92 at Taka 105 crore in place of Taka 147 crore in 1990-91. Only recently central digital locomotive repair workshop has been established at Purbatipur at a cost of Taka 203 crore. Railways have been made more active due to the establishment of integrated telecommunication network, he added.

He said efforts were on to improve the navigation sector with local resources as well as with assistance from World Bank and international financial agencies and foreign countries. 33 projects are being implemented during the current fiscal year. Implementation of two multi-purpose jetty projects and procurement of equipments for loading and unloading of goods are on way to completion.

The project for channel dredging to maintain navigability of Mongla Port as well as to supply pure drinking water there have been completed, he said adding by now two ro-ro ferries and two pontoons have been procured. Besides, two more ferries and two more pontoons will be collected to improve the communication between Aricha-Nagarbari.

Biswas said, work on modern digital exchanges for 26,000 telephone lines under six exchanges in Dhaka had also been completed under the modernisation and expansion of telecommunication system. Work on six more areas in Dhaka and the digital exchange for 60,000 lines in Narayanganj has been progressing fast.

Work on the 1920 channel digital microwave system have been completed to replace Dhaka-Khulna old microwave system. The work on telecommunication between district and thana head quarters have been fast progressing. Telecommunication has been established in 246 thanas. The establishment of 5,000 digital telephone lines will be completed this year in Dhaka. 20,500 telephone will be set up in the Chittagong Port City, he added.

Besides, the President said, phone card system with most modern technology had been introduced. In order to improve the telecommunication system, the government has already taken a decision to allow private sector to enter into the field of telecommunication, he added.

The President said, Bangladesh Biman had achieved considerable progress despite world-wide economic recession. Biman earned a profile of Taka 32 crore 40 lakh last year. Agreements were signed with Iran, Turkey, Belgium, Germany, Sri Lanka, Egypt and Vietnam for operation of Biman flights last year.

Initiatives have been taken to open Biman route to New York and Hong Kong. Two stor air crafts will be procured to establish communications with the remote areas, he added. The run ways of Zia International Airport and those at Rajshahi, Syedpur, Barisal and Cox's Bazar are being expanded and developed.

National Tourism Policy has been announced to expand tourism, he added. Tourism was now considered to be another industry. Important tourist spots are being made attractive and work is fast progressing.

Point to the health and family planning sector, the President said the goal had been set to provide health for all by the year 2000. A 60 crore dollar fourth population and health projects is being implemented to attain this objective. This is the biggest of such projects in the third world countries under World Bank assistance, he said. In the 4th five-year plan, Taka one thousand 67 crore have been earmarked for health and Taka one thousand 7 hundred crore for family welfare.

Health infrastructure have been built in the union and village level to reach health care facilities to the rural poor, he said adding several medical colleges had been established under government and private initiatives. Increased number of doctors are being provided with jobs, commendable successes have been achieved in the expanded programme of immunizations for children against six deadly diseases, he added.

The President said, work on a Taka 400 crore plan un-

der maternal and child health care programme had already been started. The tenure of this plan will end in 1995. Government is going ahead with the practical programme to control population explosion. The population explosion has been singled out as a number one problem of the country. Positive results have been achieved in consolidation and integration of the family planning programme, he added.

Spelling out the educational activities undertaken by the present government, he said, education was one of the impetus to remove poverty and develop manpower resources. So he said, highest importance had been laid on education. Primary education has been made compulsory. Primary education and mass educations have been identified as priority areas and meanwhile separate division has been set up, he said.

Programmes had been taken in hand for the development of infrastructures of different schools and colleges and for the improvement of training courses for teacher.

Open university system has been introduced for the expansion of higher education, he said adding a number of development programme had been taken up this year in the primary and higher education sectors. It includes reconstruction and rehabilitation of madrasa affected by the flood in 1988. Tuition fees for girl students up to class eight have been exempted and scholarships to be given among them, he added.

The President said, 13 projects had been taken up for the development of universities. This year national university project is being implemented.

Termining culture as the spirit of Bangladeshi nationalism, President Biswas said, priority had been given to proper rearing and flourishing of our culture. Cultural agreements have so far been signed with other countries to introduce our own cultural entity to countries worldwide. The long-expected national theatre will be built, he said adding arrangements for the establishment of folk-art village and exhibition of crafts had been made to patronise arts and handicrafts.

He said Bangla Academy had taken up programmes for publication of books on higher education, language, literature and folklore and for expansion of libraries across the country. Very soon national book policy will be announced, he added.

The historic Ahsan Manjil has been converted into museum after necessary renovation, he mentioned. Work for converting Chittagong Circuit House into Zia memorial museum is going ahead to immortalise the memory of Shahid Ziaur Rahman.

The President said during the last fiscal year a total of over one lakh eighty five thousand working forces were abroad. The remittance by these people during the year was Taka 3 thousand 2 hundred and 41 crore.

He said, commission has been constituted for the workers. It has finalised the reports. Steps had been taken to fix salaries and allowances for the workers in keeping with the cost of living. He said work on the formulation of a appropriate labour policy is on emphasis have been put on the maintenance of peaceful atmospheres in the industrial areas congenial to better production and investment by local and foreign entrepreneurs.

**Role of labourers in development emphasised**

State Minister for Environment and Forest, Fisheries and Livestock Goyeswar Chandra Roy yesterday said, labourers are playing an important role in the national development, reports BSS.

He was addressing as chief guest a labour meeting arranged by Dhaka Mahanagar Emarat Nirman Samikha Union on the occasion of the fourth founding anniversary of the union at Khilgaon.

President of the union Nurul Islam presided over the meeting. Zahiruddin, Joint Secretary of Jubodal and Abdus Sattar Howlader, founding President of the union also addressed the meeting.

**BSFIC won't reduce sugar price**

The Bangladesh Sugar and Food Industries Corporation (BSFIC) has no plan to reduce the price of sugar from existing rate as reported in a section of press, says a handout. Therefore, the ex-mill price of sugar will remain unchanged at Taka 25,000 per ton.

**Election, AGM of different units under DUJ held**

Election and annual general meeting of different units of Dhaka Union of Journalists (DUJ) were held on Saturday, reports UNB.

In the first phase, election and AGM were held in Daily Inqilab, Dainik Rupali and Weekly Natun Bangla on Saturday as per schedule announced, a DUJ press release said yesterday (Sunday).

Mohammad Salahuddin and Mizanur Rahman were re-elected unit chief and deputy unit chief respectively of the Inqilab unit of DUJ.

In Rupali, Shihabuddin Kislui was re-elected as unit chief and Bipul Chandra Roy elected deputy unit chief.

**Sadeq back home**

State Minister for Youth and Sports Sadeq Hossain returned here yesterday after a week-long visit to Malaysia, reports BSS.

During the visit, he met the Malaysian Minister for Youth and Sports Senator Anwar Musa.

The two ministers, during the meeting, stressed the need for greater cooperation in the field of sport and youth affairs between the two countries.

Malaysia has particularly given assurances of assistance for the improvement of hockey and badminton games in Bangladesh.

Besides, Hossain visited the sports complex, national sports council and national youth council meant for the 1998 commonwealth games.

The Minister led a three member delegation. The government has decided to appoint Syed Hasan Ahmed, Bangladesh Ambassador to the Kingdom of Belgium, as country's Ambassador to the European Community with residence in Brussels, said an official hand-out yesterday, reports UNB.s
