### 'Steps under way to separate judiciary from executive'

Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Minister Mirza Golam Hafiz said here yesterday that the government was taking measures for separation of the judiciary from the executive, reports BSS.

He said a proposed bill in this connection was now being scrutinized by the parliamentary

Standing Committee for Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Ministry. After scrutiny of the bill was expected to be placed before the Jatiya Sangsad either during the current winter session or in the next session by the latest, he added.

The Law Minister was addressing as chief guest a function marking the inauguration of the new district judge's court building at Jhalakati.

Additional Secretary-in-Charge of the Law and Justice Ministry Mirza Asaduzzaman Al-Farooq attended the function as the special guest while Jalaluddin Ahmed, District and Sessions Judge of Jhalakati presided. Abdul Mannan Siddik, President of the district Bar Association also spoke.

The court building, constructed at a cost of taka 243 lakh, house six courts under the judgeship of Jhalakati with 37,000 sq ft floor space.  
Mirza Golam Hafiz said rule of law must be established in the society for the welfare of the people. Equality before law and equal protection of law would have to be ensured, he stressed.

The Law Minister sought active cooperation of the lawyers for ensuring justice and establishing rule of law in the country. He also called for maintaining good working relationship between the bench and the bar, saying the lawyers are the inseparable part of the judiciary.

Earlier, the Law Minister, unveiled the plaque of the new district judge's court building and offered munajat.

The topics covered at the workshop include principles of water and Sediment Movement, morphological computation, scale modelling of river engineering problems, and design and structural aspects of river training works.
