

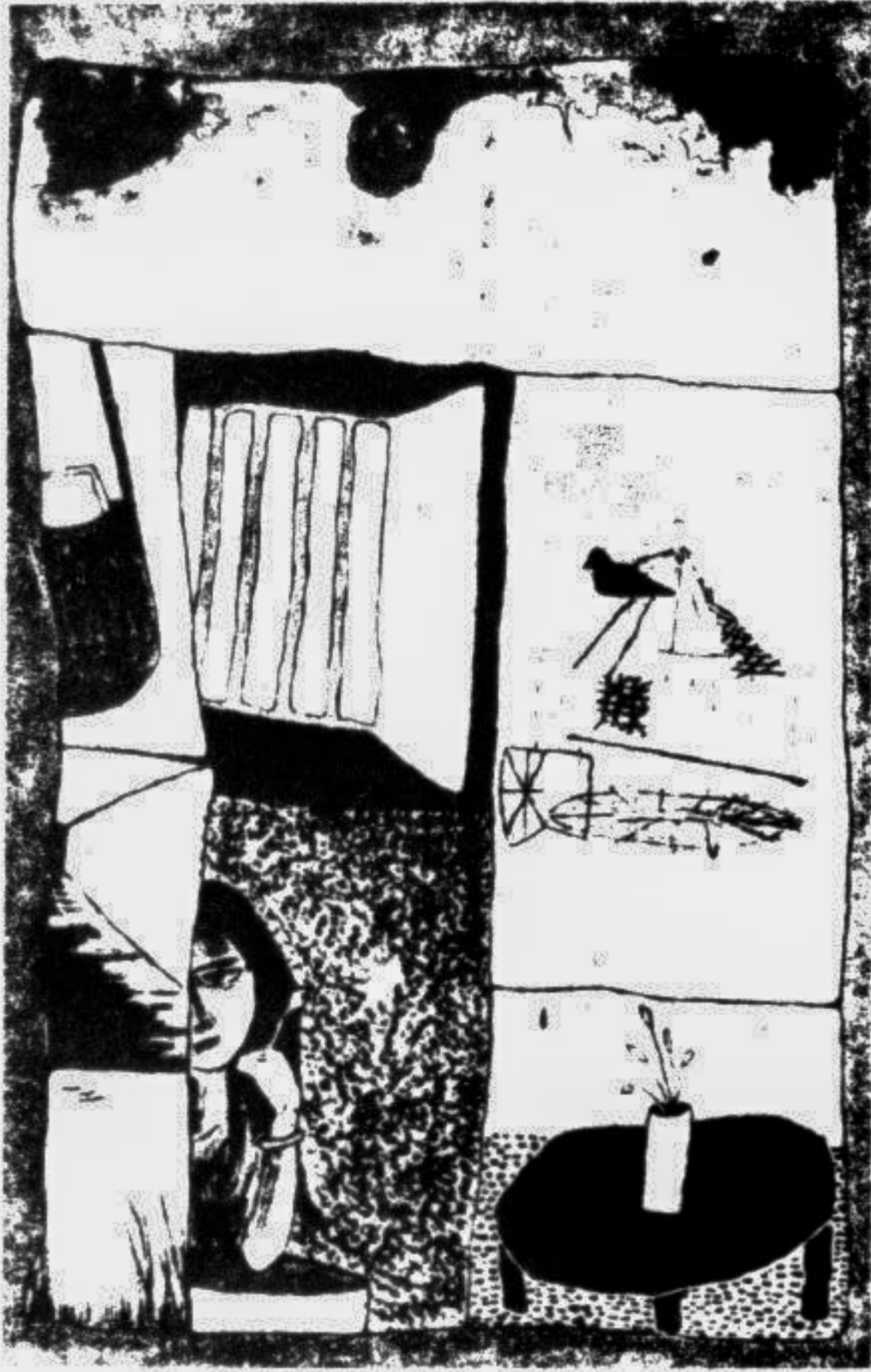

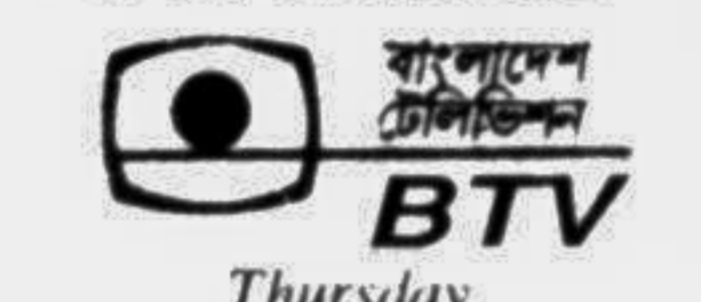
Information Minister Nazmul Huda yesterday said that the existing excellent bilateral relations between Bangladesh and France would be strengthened further...

Bishwa Itjema Special trains from today

Bangladesh Railway will run special trains from January 14 to 20 to facilitate the travelling of the pilgrims of forthcoming Bishwa Itjema...

On January 14, 15, 16 and 17 the following special trains will run for Tongi: (A) Mymensingh dep. 10-10 pm Tongi arriv. 11-15 pm, (B) Bhairabazar dep. 10 pm Tongi arriv. 12-55 pm, (C) Akhaura dep. 1-40 pm Tongi arriv. 4-15 pm.

On these days all inter-city trains, excluding the Mahanagar, will stop at Tongi station for two minutes.

On January 18 the following special trains will run from Tongi:

(A) Tongi dep. 1-20 pm Akhaura arriv. 4-35 pm, (B) Tongi dep. 1-25 pm Mymensingh arriv. 4-15 pm, (C) Tongi dep. 5 pm Akhaura arriv. 9 pm, (D) Tongi dep. 10-50 pm Mymensingh arriv. 2-10 am.

Besides, four special trains will also run between Tongi and Dhaka on January 18 leaving Tongi at 1 pm, 1-30 pm, 2-30 pm and 4-30 pm respectively...

On January 19 and 20 the following special trains will run from Tongi:

(A) Tongi dep. 1:20 pm Akhaura arriv. 4:35 pm, (B) Tongi dep. 10:50 pm Mymensingh arriv. 2:10 am, (C) Tongi dep. 12:50 am Bhairabazar arriv. 3:05 am.

TSS installs 45 more card phones in city

The Telephone Shilpa Sangstha (TSS) installed 45 more card phones in important public places of Dhaka city in the last few weeks...

Twelve card phones will be installed in Chittagong tomorrow, according to T & T sources.

TSS will install six card phones in Khulna, four in Rajshahi, four in Barisal, four in Sylhet, two in Narayanganj and six others in other important towns by February.

TSS started installation of such card phone booths since September 29 last to increase accessibility of telephone facilities to the public.

According to a monitoring report of TSS between the period from September 29 to January 10, a total number of about 1.47 million unit calls have been made from these card phones...
