Zahir for easy access of LDC products to developed world

Planning Minister AM Zahiruddin Khan yesterday called for providing an easy access of products of the Least Developed Countries (LDC's) to the markets of the developed world, reports BSS.

The minister also urged the developed countries to take a special view towards the trade issues of the LDCs at the current Uruguay Round of multilateral trade negotiations under the GATT.

Underlining the need for an early and successful conclusion of the negotiations, he expressed the hope that a fair global trading system and an equitable arrangement of trade would be the outcome of the Uruguay Round of negotiations now at the final stage.

Khan was presiding over a session of round-table discusat the on-going Bangladesh seminar on GATT and Uruguay Round" organised. by the Tariff Commission in cooperation with the Genevabased GATT Secretariat.

He said that the growth of economies and pulling up of the Gross National Product (GNP) of the LDCs would depend on the rapid expansion of trade of the respective coun-

Chairman of Tariff Commission Dr Mohiuddin Khan Alamgir, Director of Special Projects Division of GATT Secretariat Eiric Soronsen, Mario Kakabadse and Dr Dickson Yeboah of the **GATT Secretariat and Division** Chief of Planning Commission

Dr Ml Talukder, took part in the round table discussion which was participated by members of parliament, concerned officials, researchers and representatives of Chambers of Commerce and

The Planning Minister said under the present unipolar world the atmosphere was inducive to cooperation rather than confrontation and added "under the circumstances we are anxious to see a friutful outcome of the GAAT negotia-

Khan said trade barriers and forming of economic blocks could never bring to an

end of the war of trade between the various countries.

Referring to the development attained by the countries of the South East Asian region trough adopting the strategy of export - led growth, the minister pointed out that "the choice left before us is trade and not aid. "

Sørensen dwelt on the various aspects of the Uruguay Round of negotiations and said the draft final act, once agreed upon by the member states, could lead to the setting up of a broadbased multilateral trade organisation more effective than GATT.
