### Shamsul for large scale production of spirulina

Industries Minister Shamsul Islam Khan yesterday suggested that Bangladesh Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (BCSIR) lease out their spirulina production technology at less premium to attract the entrepreneurs, reports BSS.

Talking to the scientists of BCSIR at its committee room the Minister said the technology should be leased out to a large number of entrepreneurs so that they could go for large scale production and make this food available to the people at a minimum cost.

Spirulina is a microscopic plant rich in Vitamin A, B-12, iron and protein.

The process for culture of spirulina was developed by the scientists of BCSIR with French economic assistance and technology.

The minister visited spirulina production ponds at the BCSIR campus and expressed keen interest for its spread all over the country to meet the nutrition needs of the children as well as the adults.

Member, science and technology of BCSIR, Dr M Eusuf, all directors of BCSIR in Dhaka and Director, Planning of Bangladesh Small and Cottage Industries Corporation were present.

### WFP workshop begins

A regional workshop on Monitoring, Reporting and Evaluation (MRE) of World Food Programme (WFP) assisted projects began here yesterday in the office of the United Nations World Food Programme, reports BSS.

Presided over by Gaston Eyben, Director of Operations, World Food Programme, Bangladesh, the workshop was inaugurated by Nazrul Islam, Secretary, Implementation, Monitoring and Evaluation Division (IMED), Ministry of Planning.

Twenty senior government and WFP officials from Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Indonesia, Nepal and Sri Lanka are participating in the workshop.

The eight-day intensive training workshop will examine the key functions concerned with food-assisted project management particularly in the context of monitoring, reporting and evaluation of food-assisted development projects.

### 'Environmental degradation poses threat to biological species in tropical region'

British environmental scientist Dr L M Cook said here yesterday that due to environmental degradation and loss of habitat most of the biological species in the tropical regions were under threat endangering the man himself, reports BSS.

He was giving a talk on "diversity of biological species in the universe" held at the gallery of Zoology Department of Dhaka University.

Professor Cook who is now visiting Bangladesh as a guest of Dhaka University, said most of the biological species in the world were located in the tropical countries but their number decreased alarmingly in the last 50 years.

He presented a mathematical model suggesting ways to protect bio-diversity in the universe.

Pro-Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University Professor Wakil Ahmed was the chief guest on the occasion, while Chairman of the Zoology Department of Dhaka University and President of Bangladesh Zoological Society Professor Shahadat Ali was in the chair.

Sabina Sultana (Reba), wife of Mohammad Bakhtiar Alam Rana, a senior ASP of the Prime Minister's special security force, died of brain haemorrhage at the PG hospital here Saturday. She was 30, reports BSS.
