Mahila Parishad rally held Democracy jeopardised by violent incidents

The women's right organisation, Bangladesh Mahila Parishad Monday expressed its concern over the lawlessness in the country and demanded punishment to the miscreants involved in incidents like Halishbar.

The Parishad at a rally held in protest against the suicide of Nurjahan, the Halishbar and the Babri Mosque incidents said that democracy was jeopardised by violent incidents which the government was unable to resist.

The press conference held in front of the National Press Club was presided over by the Chairperson of the Parishad Begum Sufia Kamal while its central leaders Ayesha Khanam, Rakhti Das Purakayastha, Laxmi Chakrabarti, Dr Makhbula Nargis Ratna addressed. Baby Moudud conducted the programme.

The leaders said that Nurjahan, a young woman of Kamalganj committed suicide

early this month as she was humiliated and tortured brutally before public by one Moulana Mannan.

They said, while there is a government and a constitution, how can a Moulana organise trial of a woman which had compelled her to commit suicide.

Sufia Kamal warned the administration saying "If you do not take actions against such atrocities, the women will take the law in their hands."
