2 lakh cows inseminated artificially

RAJSHAHI, Jan 31: The Livestocks Department has artificially inseminated about one lakh 95 thousand cows during the first six months of the eurrent fiscal year in Rajshahi division achieving the yearly tar get by 50 per cent, reports 1355.

During the period the de partment has vaccinated 18 lakh 20 thousand cattleheads and two crore 95 thousand hens and ducks in the division achieving the yearly target by 22 and 38 percent respectively.

Abut four lakh 85 thousand cattleheads and 13 lakh 30 thousand poults have been provided treatment during the time.

The department also distributed about one lakh 68 thousand day-old poults, one lakh improved species of hens, 39 thousand ducks and one lakh 5 thousand eggs of hens and ducks among the farmers during the time.
