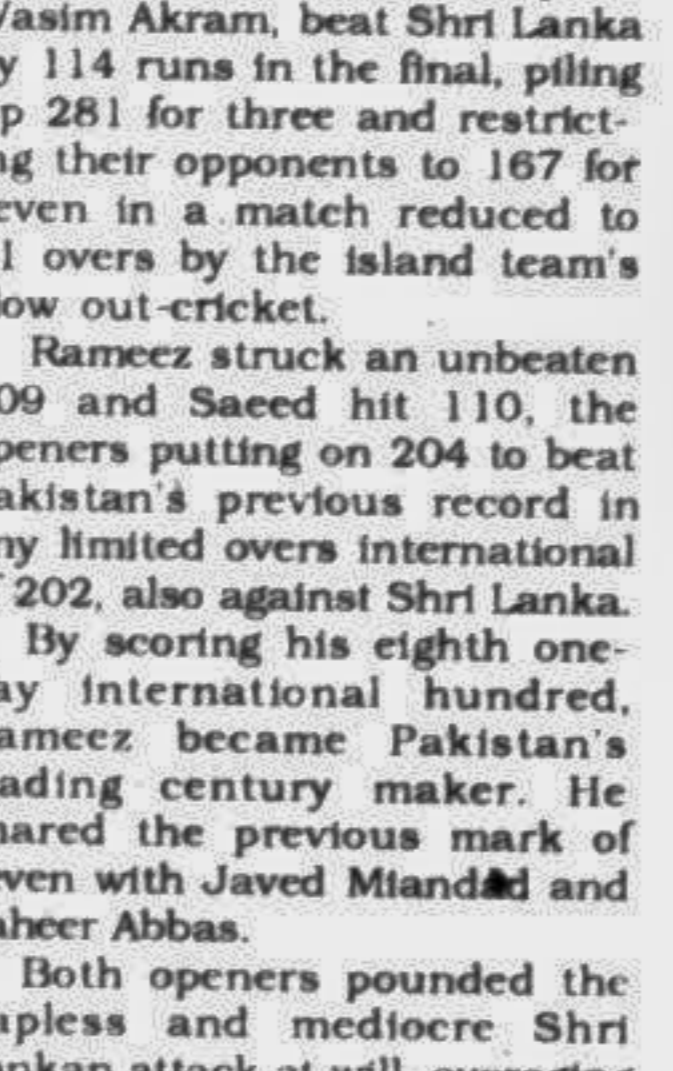

SCOREBOARD: Scoreboard in the Sharjah Trophy one-day cricket final between Pakistan and Sri Lanka today.

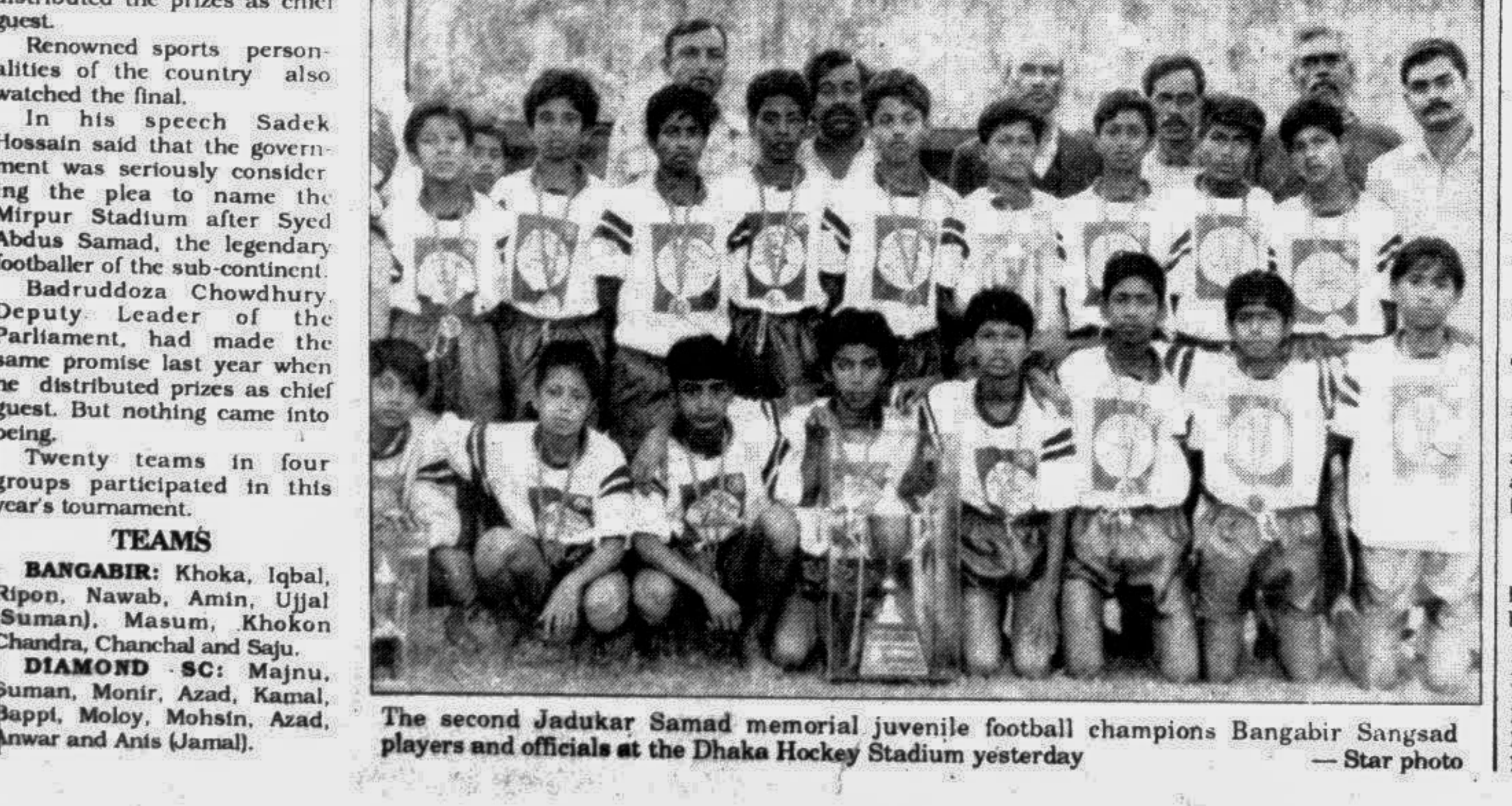
3.6m tickets on sale, price ranges from \$ 25-\$ 475 Ticket sales plans for WC '94 unveiled
