He said liquor worth Taka 5.03 crore during that period was imported from the United Kingdom, Taka 1.81 crore from Singapore, Taka 1.11 crore from Canada, Taka 0.99 crore from France, Taka 0.43 crore from Denmark, Taka 0.25 crore from Australia and Taka 0.83 crore from other countries.

He added that during the 1990-91 fiscal year 19 lakh litres of liquor were imported at a total cost of about Taka 12 crore.

Replying to a supplemen-

tary question, the Minister said that no fresh liquor importing licence was issued during 1991-92.

A total of 17.11 lakh litres of liquor worth Taka 10.45 crore was imported into the country during the 1991-92 fiscal year.

This was disclosed in Parliament by Commerce Minister M K Anwar in reply to a question by Jamaat-e-Islami member from Jessore Maulana Muhammad Sakhawat Hossain yesterday.


