ICM submits memorandum to Indian High Commission

Police stopped several thousand activists of Islami Constitution Movement (ICM-Islami Shashantatra Andolon) marching towards the Indian High Commission Saturday to demand reconstruction of Babri Mosque on its original site.

A special division of riot police barricaded the marchers near the Science Laboratory gate and allowed four of their representatives to hand over a memorandum to the High Commission.

The activists, led by Pir Saheb of Charmonai Maulana Syed Fazul Karim staged a sit-in on the New Elephant Road until the representatives came back after handing over the memo at around 1:00 pm.

They were reciting religious verses and chanting slogan 'India will break into pieces as consequence of mosque demolition.'

In the memo addressed to Indian Prime Minister Narasimha Rao they placed a five-point demand including ban on worship at the makeshift temple on 'Babri Mosque' site, protection of minority Muslim in India and compensation for the victims of communal violence. It also urged Indian authorities to resolve bilateral disputes like Talpatti, Farakkah through dialogue.

One security official received that memo as the High Commission was closed on Saturday, the weekly holiday.

Earlier, before starting the march from near the Baitul Mukarram Mosque, Maolana Fazul Karim told his supporters that 'everything happened in India with the help of Rao government.'

BCAA projects reviewed

The 12th meeting of the standing committee on the Ministry of Civil Aviation and Tourism was held yesterday at the Sangsad Bhaban with State Minister for Civil Aviation and Tourism Abdul Mannan in the chair, reports BSS.

The meeting reviewed the various ongoing projects of the Bangladesh Civil Aviation Authority (BCAA) and gave some important suggestions for its overall development.

The meeting was informed that Civil Aviation Authority had taken steps to modernize the country's different airports. The meeting stressed the need for construction of second runway at the Zia International Airport and to convert the Sylhet and Chittagong Airports into international airports.

Committee members Shah Hadiuzzaman, Sk Fazul Karim Selim, Begum Rahima Khandakar, Mr Alam Khan, Saiful Azam and Secretary, Ministry of Civil Aviation and Tourism Habibur Rahman, Managing Director of Bangladesh Biman, Abdul Moeed Chowdhury, Chairman Bangladesh Civil Aviation Authority, Air Commodore Shamser Ali, among others, were present in the meeting.

Obituary

Deputy Director of Government Accommodation, Department Mohammad Sanaullah died on February 18 after a massive heart attack at Suhrawardi Hospital. He was 55, reports UNB.

Sanaullah left behind his wife, two sons, two daughters and a number of relatives and admirers.

He was buried at his native village Begumganj in Noakhali district.

A condolence meeting was held at the office of the Director of Government Accommodation in the Secretariat. The meeting expressed deep shock at the death of Sanaullah and prayed for the salvation of the departed soul.

Application of cancer diagnosis method with needle suggested

A health expert yesterday suggested application of a simple method of cancer diagnosis with needle called fine needle aspiration cytology which is considered the easiest and inexpensive means convenient of the developing nations like Bangladesh.

The advantage of the technique, besides its simplicity and accuracy, is that the material for examination can be aspirated from multiple sites of cancer without much discomfort to the patients and the result can be given within an hour," Prof MB Zaman told UNB.

Dr Zaman, an expatriate Bangladeshi, Professor of Pathology at New York Medical College and chief of Cytology unit of Westchester Medical Centre and consultant in cytology of world's largest cancer hospital, Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Centre in New York, conducted a four-day long intensive course on Fine Needle Aspiration Cytology which ended yesterday at the Cancer Institute at Mohakhali.

He said this process also helps in obtaining a pre-operative diagnosis to help the surgeons in planning an operative strategy.

"It is non-invasive, economic and simple process to identify cancer, particularly in any superficial cancer in breast, head and neck and lymph nodes. It could be carried out in peripheral areas of this poverty-stricken country for cancer diagnosis where health facilities are too little."

Dr Zaman said most of the about 50 types of cancer identified exist in Bangladesh. Some eight lakh cancer patients are there in Bangladesh now, and about 1.5 lakh of them are dying every year.

"When a malignant tumor is adequately sampled, diagnosis is instant and no laborious screening is necessary by this fine needle aspiration cytology process to identify cancer."

Jointly organised by WHO and the Bangladesh Society of Pathologists, the course on 'Fine Needle Aspiration Cytology' was the followup of the third International congress of Societies of Pathologists held in Dhaka Feb 14-17. About 29 pathologists, including one from India, attended the course.

Dr Sheema Hasan of Aga Khan University Medical College in Karachi, WHO Representative Prof Myo Thwe, Prof Habibuz Zaman and Dr A/E Nahar also spoke at the concluding session yesterday.
