'Coastal resources can contribute to uplift'

Planning Minister AM Zahiruddin Khan underscored the need for an integrated approach for sustainable and environmentally compatible development of coastal resources, reports BSS. He said, if the coastal resources could be optimally utilised, it could contribute to the socio-economic development of the country. Khan was addressing a meeting on coastal area integrated resources management plan preparation held in the city yesterday at the NEC Bhaban. Members of Parliament, particularly from coastal areas, the Planning Minister opined that it was a physical demonstration which reflected the concept of participatory planning. He also urged the members of the parliament for their involvement in the development process. Khan also welcomed the exchange of dialogues among government officials, policy makers, planners and people's representatives in the planning process to formulate a people-oriented plan for the country. About 25,000 square kilometer or 17 per cent of the total area of the country may be designated as the coastal areas it remains under coastal tidal influence. About 19 per cent of the country's population live in the coastal area. The coast of Bangladesh is dynamic and its ecology is very fragile. Referring to the participation of the Members of Parliament, particularly from coastal areas, the Planning Minister opined that it was a physical demonstration which reflected the concept of participatory planning. He also urged the members of the parliament for their involvement in the development process. Khan also welcomed the exchange of dialogues among government officials, policy makers, planners and people's representatives in the planning process to formulate a people-oriented plan for the country.

'Keep prices of essentials under buying capacity'

Commerce Minister M K Anwar yesterday urged the businessmen to keep the prices of the essentials at a reasonable level and under the buying capacity of the common people during the holy month of Ramzan, reports BSS. He made this call while talking to the traders of different markets of Dhaka city on demand, supply and prices of daily necessary commodities during his visit there. Chairman, Trading Corporation of Bangladesh and senior officials of the Ministry of Commerce were with the minister. Anwar observed that the supply of rice, pulses, onion, garlic, potato, fish, meat, vegetables and fruits were satisfactory. The dealers informed the minister that prices of items were under the buying capacity of the consumers. The traders said that the lowest price of rice is now Taka 8.50 only per kg which was about Taka 9.50 per kg in the last year. The price of Masur Dal is now Taka 28.00 per kg which was Taka 30.00 per kg in the previous year. The butchers informed the minister that they were selling the beef at Taka 55.00 per kg which is approved by the authorities. The traders also informed that the prices of some items including fish and spices had been increased. The minister told them that the government would take measures to increase the supply of those items. The minister sought cooperation of the traders and the members of the law enforcing agencies to keep vigilance so that no vested quarters could make any artificial crisis of any daily necessary commodities by any illegal means. The government would take stern measures against those anti-social elements, he added.

Certain party misleading thru' falsehood: Huda

DOHAR (Dhaka), Feb 28: Information Minister Barrister Nazmul Huda today inaugurated the re-excavation of Mahmudpur-Radhanagar canal under Dohar police station. The re-excavation of the four and a half kilometre-long canal will bring 1200 acres of land under irrigation. As a result two thousand metric tons of additional winter crops alongside other crops are expected to be produced in the command area. He said the leader of a certain party has been misleading the people through falsehood. Criticising those indulging in the acts of terrorism he said terrorism would have to be eliminated at any cost. The terrorists would be punished, but no innocent person would be harassed under the Anti-Terrorism Law, he added. The Information Minister said the BNP government believed in the politics of peace and development. He called upon the newly elected Union Parishad chairmen to submit concrete proposals for the development of local areas. In this connection, he pointed out that the present government was committed to fulfil all election pledges including the development of roads and supply of electricity. The Information Minister directed the local administration to put down terrorism with iron hand.

Pak envoy calls on Harun PM condoles death of Sonagazi thana BNP President

Anwar Kemal, High Commissioner of Pakistan in Bangladesh called on Harun-al-Rashid, Minister of State for Shipping at the latter's office here yesterday, reports BSS. They discussed different issues of mutual interest, particularly the issue of purchasing two-container ships from Pakistan for Bangladesh Shipping Corporation under the financial assistance of Pakistan. The State Minister hoped that the existing relations between the two friendly countries would be further strengthened in the days to come. Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia yesterday condoled the death of Sonagazi thana BNP President, Abdullah Chowdhury, reports BSS. In a message of condolence Begum Zia recalled the contributions of late Chowdhury to the party. She expressed sympathy to the members of the bereaved family. Begum Zia prayed for peace of the departed soul. Chowdhury also worked as UP Chairman for 20 years. He died on February 27 last.

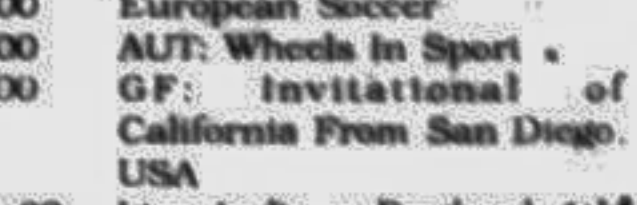
