Garment industries back SKOP strike call

Different trade unions of garment industries yesterday expressed solidarity with the strike called by Sramik Karmochari Oikya Parishad (SKOP) on March 15 and 16 and urged the garment workers to make the programme a success.

The trade union leaders demanded immediate implementation of their seven-point charter of demands that includes declaration and implementation of Wage Board Awards having Tk 1400 as the lowest wage scale for workers.

The leaders at a press conference also demanded payment of Eid bonus with due wages to the workers by 20th Ramadan, banning working hour after 8 pm for women and stopping forceful overtime.

It was addressed by Strajul Islam Ronny, President of Sammlita Garments Sramik-Karmochari League while President and Secretary of Bangladesh Garments Sramik Karmochari Federation Abul Hossain and Mohar Ali, General Secretary of Bangladesh Garments Workers Federation Rafiqul Islam Matna, Garments Sramik-Karmochari Union President and GS Shahidullah Badal and Touhidur Rahman, President of Bangladesh Jatyatabadi Garments Sramik Dal Shahidul Islam, President and GS of Sammlita Garments Sramik Jote Harun-ur-Rashid and Shafiqur Rahman attended.

They said that although the government and the garment owners agreed to implement their seven-point charter of demands in July last, they were yet to take steps in this connection. On the other hand, the owners' associations had requested the government not to declare the new Wage Board awards while the Finance Minister M Saifur Rahman termed as "economic terrorism."

The leaders condemned the Finance Minister for making such a comment. Although the garments sector fetch huge foreign currencies every year, the garment workers' leaders pointed out that presently export of garments was affected by the government's shortsighted and faulty policies.

Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia has thanked Prime Minister Dr Hamed Karoui of Tunisia for his message of felicitation on the occasion of the holy month of Ramadan, reports UNB.
