Steps to ensure rights of minorities suggested

Bangladesh Hindu Buddhist Christian Oikya Parishad Saturday called upon the SAARC countries to take measures for ensuring the rights of the minorities in the region.

A meeting of the central committee of the Parishad also urged the countries to ban religion-based politics in the region.

The meeting also decided to submit memoranda in this regard to the SAARC Secretariat and the Chiefs of the SAARC states.

The meeting presided over by T Rozario was addressed, among others, by Major General (Retd) CR Datta, Justice Debesh Chandra Bhattacharya, Advocate Sudhangshu Shekhar Haldar MP, Suranjit Sen Gupta MP, Advocate Dharendra Nath Shambhu MP, Prof Paritosh Chakravarty MP, Kalpa Ranjan Chakma MP, Dr Lollito Mohan Nath, Barrister Sudhir Chandra Das, Nikunja Bihari Goshwami, Advocate Siril Shikdar and Dr Rama Das Gupta.

The Parishad has also taken up elaborate programmes from April 22 to December 10 to press home its demand.

The programmes include a grand rally on April 22, observance of Black Day on June 11, observance of Shame Day on October 30, observance of Distressed Day on December 6 and Human Rights Day on December 10.

105 arrested on various charges

Police rounded up 105 people on various charges from different parts of the city yesterday, reports UNB.

A police press release said the arrested include eight wanted criminals, one charged with murder, one under the Anti-terrorism Act, one accused of kidnapping, six of burglary and another six of stealing.

All the arrested people were produced before the court, the press release added.

Ahmed Bawani Textile Mills needs immediate BMRE

The Ahmed Bawani Textile Mills, an enterprise of Bangladesh Textiles Mills Corporation (BTMC), needs immediate Balancing, Modernisation, Rehabilitation and Expansion (BMRE) to compete with modern textile mills set up at private sector, reports BSS.

This was stated by Abdul Quddus, General Manager of the mills to a group of journalists when they visited the mills yesterday.

Giving a background of the mill, Quddus said the mill which was established in 1955 requires immediate BMRE to run it profitably. He said Taka 14 crore would be required for this purpose.

The General Manager said during the past 20 years the mills earned profit 11 times and incurred loss nine times. He said due to huge stockpiling since October '92 the mill was now incurring heavy loss. He said goods, including yarn and clothes, worth Taka 13 crore had remained unsold.

He however, said the present products do not remain unsold as those were supplied to Bangladesh Army, Bangladesh Air Force and Family Planning Directorate.

Quddus said the mill was supplying clothes worth 78,000 US dollars to Italy under an export agreement.

Replying to a question the General Manager said the mill would not incur any financial loss if it remained open but would suffer a loss to the tune of Taka three lakh everyday if it remained closed.

There are 2050 workers, 265 employees and 51 officials working in the mills. He told a questioner that under the golden hand-shake programme 152 workers and four officials had expressed their willingness to go for retirement.
